



## **All-Star Program**

- The All-Star Program is designed for local high school students in El Paso County and Dona Ana County who are not only stand outs in the classroom, but also stand outs in the community.
- This program helps students informationally and financially who are in pursuit of a post-secondary education.
- Students can enter the All-Star Program as freshmen and will continue until graduation. To remain in the program students will have to maintain a minimum of a 2.5 GPA on a 4.0 scale and contribute a minimum of 20 hours of community service per year.
- Throughout their time in the program All-Stars will be invited to luncheons with information on topics such as financial aid, college applications, etc. College tours and meetings with admissions counselors to local post-secondary schools will be included.
- Each year the El Paso Chihuahuas will recognize the five newest members of the program as well those who will be graduating from the program.
- Students will be judged based on academic performance, extra-curricular and community activities, community service, and financial need, and will be selected by a committee of volunteers.
- A scholarship of \$1,000 will be awarded one time, directly to the post-secondary school, only after the student has shown proof of full-time enrollment.
