Today's Preview: The Clinton LumberKings (A, Mariners) meet the Peoria Chiefs (A, Cardinals) for the second time this season with the finale of a three game-set. In the team's first meeting this year, the Chiefs took three out of four from the LumberKings over a four-game stretch at Dozer Park in Peoria. Clinton avoided being swept in the four-game set with a 7-2 win on May 17. Still the LumberKings could have had a split of the series had it had not been a Chiefs come from behind win 7-5 on May 16, a game which Clinton led at one point 5-0. The LumberKings lead the all-time series, dating back to 1983, 240 to 215. Since Clinton has been affiliated with the Seattle Mariners (2009) they lead in the head-to-head matchups 79 games to 56.

LumberKings Starter: Ray Kerr, 23, makes his 10th appearance and fourth start of the season for the Clinton LumberKings. The California native took the loss his last time out for a 5.1 inning performance against the Quad Cities River Bandits at Ashford University. He allowed four runs on 11 hits, two going for home runs, while walking none and striking out four. This season, Kerr has worked exclusively as a starter but has missed one of his scheduled starts this season. During his season debut against the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers, he logged just three innings before a blister developed on his pitching hand and forced him from the game and made him miss his next scheduled start. The skip in the rotation along with a handful of postponements due to the poor weather in April meant Kerr was idle for nearly two weeks between his first and second start of the season. The lefty has worked into the sixth inning in each of his last three starts, and his 11 hits surrendered in his last start were the most allowed by a LumberKings pitcher this season. The Seattle Mariners signed Kerr as a nondrafted free agent on August 22, 2017 out of Lassen Community College. An avid fisherman, he has told us that if he were not in baseball he would be a professional fisherman.

Chiefs Starter: Alex Fagalde, 24, makes his fourth appearance and third start of the season for the Peoria Chiefs. The California native last worked at home against the Burlington Bees and received a no decision for his time out. He turned in his second consecutive six inning performance, allowing one run, unearned, on four hits while walking three and striking out nine. This will be his first start against Clinton this season as Fagalde came to Peoria in the series following the LumberKings trip to Peoria in mid-May. He was a three-sport athlete in high school, playing baseball, football, and track and field before continued his baseball career at Cuesta before transferring to UC Riverside where the St. Louis Cardinals selected him in the 30th round of the 2017 MLB Draft. Fagalde led the Highlanders in wins during his senior season and second in ERA and moved into the starting rotation after beginning the season in the bullpen.

Last Time Out: In their first shutout win since April 13th the Clinton LumberKings dropped the Peoria Chiefs 5-0 on Saturday night at Ashford University Field to move back into first place in the Western Division. LumberKings (31-24) pitchers Clay Chandler and Sam Delaplaine combined to blank the Chiefs (31-25) for the team's third shutout win of the season. The first runs of the night came across in the bottom of the second inning against Chiefs starter Johan Oviedo. Ryan Costello started the rally with a single to center and was then followed by a Dimas Ojeda walk. With runners at first and second Lois Boyd singled through the right side of the infield to score Costello and move Ojeda to third. A wild pitch from Oviedo then brought home the second run of the inning for Clinton, putting them on top for good. Sam Delaplaine came on in relief of Chandler with one out in the seventh inning and went the rest of the way for the LumberKings. Over his 2.2 innings of work, he did not allow a hit while walking two and striking out four. The win snaps the Chiefs winning streak at six games and moves Clinton back into first place with the LumberKings now given a chance to take their fourth straight series with a win on Sunday.

Patience is a Virtue: The biggest rally of the night came for the Clinton LumberKings in the bottom of the fifth when they sent nine men to the plate to bat around and pull away from the Chiefs. The rally was one that came for free as Clinton did not tally a hit in the frame, instead drawing five walks, having a batter hit by a pitch, and benefiting from two wild pitches. The five free passes represent the most walks worked by the LumberKings in a single inning this season.

Add it to the Pile: Saturday marked another game for the LumberKings without a committing an error, making it now 32 of their 55 games in which they have failed to commit a defensive miscue. The errorless games have led to a robust .980 fielding percentage, the highest in the Midwest League. Currently, Johnny Adams ranks with the best fielding percentage of any shortstop in the league with a .946.

And the Seesaw Continues: The seesaw continued for the LumberKings atop of the Western Division with their win over the Peoria Chiefs moving them back into first place. The LumberKings have spent 31 days of the 2018 season either tied for or in first place on their own. A win today would keep the LumberKings in first place for consecutive days for the first time since May 14 and 15 when Clinton, despite losses to the Peoria Chiefs in Peoria, maintained a skringling lead in the West.

A Long Time 'A Comin': A shutout win by the Clinton LumberKings 5-0 on Saturday night moved them back into first place in the Western Division and was the rarest of wins this season. The LumberKings have just three shutout wins this season and their last came back on April 13th in Cedar Rapids, started by a pitcher now in the Tampa Bay Rays system, Tommy Romero.

This date in baseball history: On this date in 2003, slugger Sammy Sosa is ejected from the game during the first inning after he shatters his bat and the broken remains expose cork. The Cub outfielder will be suspended by major league baseball for eight games (reduced to 7 after an appeal) for his offense.

LAST TIME OUT: Kerr took the loss his last time out for a 5.1 inning outing against the Quad Cities River Bandits. He allowed 11 hits on the night, most allowed by a LumberKings pitcher this year, yet held the River Bandits to four runs while walking none and striking out four. The LumberKings fell 4-2 to Quad Cities to fall a game and half out of first place at the time.

AGAINST THE CHIEFS: This will be Kerr's second start against the Peoria Chiefs. He last faced them in Peoria on May 14 and was given the loss for a 2.2 inning outing in which he allowed three runs on two hits while walking four and striking out one.
