Today's Preview: The Clinton LumberKings (A, Mariners) meet the Burlington Bees (A, Angels) for the second time this season with the fourth game of a five game-set. This is the Bees second visit to Clinton in 2018, the LumberKings took both games in rained shortened two game set at Ashford University Field April 17 through 19. The April 18th rain out will be made up as part of a doubleheader on Tuesday evening. The LumberKings trail the all-time series, dating back to 1963, 417 to 430. Since Clinton has been affiliated with the Seattle Mariners (2009) they are tied in the head-to-head matchups 80 games to 80.

LumberKings Starter: Tommy Romero, 20, makes his ninth appearance and start of the season for the Clinton LumberKings. The Florida native earned the win his last time out. The start was the best by a LumberKings starter this season. Romero shutout the Kernels over his seven innings of work to earn his third win of the season. He allowed just four hits while walking none and striking out seven. Romero began his season by striking out eight batters in each of his first two starts and comes into this start against the Burlington Bees fourth best strikeout per nine inning ratio in the Midwest League, 10.85. The Seattle Mariners selected him in the 15th round of the 2017 MLB Draft out of Eastern Florida State University. Baseball America ranked Romero as the Mariners 26th best prospect in the organization coming into this season.

Bees Starter: Oliver Ortega, 21, makes his second appearance and first start of the season for the Burlington Bees. The Dominican native is coming off a season debut against the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers in which he earned the win for four innings of relief work in which he did not allow a run. Ortega allowed just two hits and walked one while striking out three. The appearance was his first in the professional ranks since 2016 after rehabbing an injury. He last pitched in the Arizona League after appearing in the Dominican Summer League in 2015 after signing as an International Free Agent. He is still thought my many scouts to possess the best curveball in the Los Angeles Angels farm system. Going into the 2017 season, Ortega was mentioned as one of the top prospects in the organization following a 2016 season in which he posted a 2.83 ERA, .156 opponent batting average, and 0.87 WHIP; impressive numbers from the offensive laden Arizona League.

Last Time Out: The Clinton LumberKings split a doubleheader with the Burlington Bees on Tuesday night, dropping game one 4-0 and then taking game two 3-2 in walk-off fashion. The doubleheader will be one of three the LumberKings (23-19) will play over the next six days. Clinton took a shutout loss in game one of the twin billing. The LumberKings tallied just three hits, all singles, in just their second shutout loss of the season. Burlington (18-25) did most of their damage in the first inning of game one. The Bees sent eight men to bat against LumberKings starter Clay Chandler, pushing across three runs in the inning. The second game of the doubleheader was controlled by the Bees most of the way. Nick Wells made his ninth start of the season for the LumberKings and allowed a first inning run following a leadoff triple by Leonardo Rivas and RBI single by Franklin Torres. In the top of the fourth inning, the Bees added to their lead with a solo home run by Kevin Williams, his first big fly of the season. Trailing 2-0, the LumberKings broke out for two runs in the bottom of the sixth inning. Jack Larsen drove home both runs with a double to right center field to score Joseph Rosa and Ariel Sandoval. Rosario (1-1) nearly exited the bases loaded jam with nobody out when Joseph Rosa lined out to third basemen Gleyvin Pineda and doubled Boyd off the bag at third for a double play. A seven-pitch battle then started with Eugene Helder who saw both runners advance on a wild pitch to put the winning run on third for the second time in the inning. Helder then grounded a ball to second that Julio Garcia misplayed and then rushed a wild throw to first that went down the first base line allowing Scott to score from third for the second LumberKings walk-off win in as many nights.

One Down Three to Go: Tuesday marked a stretch of nine games to be played by the LumberKings over the next six days. Tuesday's doubleheader was the first-of-three twin billings for Clinton this week. The double dip ended with a split, Clinton dropping game one 4-0 and rallying to come from behind in a 3-2 walk-off win in the night cap.

Rare Shutout: The Clinton LumberKings own one of the most consistent offenses in the Midwest League. This season, with 42 games in the books, they have still not been shutout in a regulation nine inning game. Both of the LumberKings shutout losses this season have come in doubleheader games of just seven innings, in game one to the Kane County Cougars 1-0 on April 8th and last night in game one 4-0 to the Burlington Bees.

Back-to-Back?: Another walk-off win by the Clinton LumberKings was the team's third of the season and the second of the series. Clinton walked off Burlington 4-3 in 10 innings on Monday night before repeating the feat in game two of the doubleheader on Tuesday night. Both walk-off wins came in unorthodox ways. Monday night, Clinton rallied for two runs, winning on a bases loaded hit-by-pitch. In Tuesday's walk-off win, the LumberKings loaded the bases with nobody out only to see a lineup of a double play that doubled the runner off the bag at third for the second out. Still Clinton put runners at second and third when Eugene Helder rolled a ball to second that was misplayed twice by Bees second basemen Julio Garcia before he threw it down the right field line for a walk-off win via an error.

At Last: The longest extra base hit drought of the season came to an end for the LumberKings in game two of their walk-off win on Tuesday night. Jack Larsen flew a two-run double to right center field to tie the game for the LumberKings, the second two bagger of the inning. Joseph Rosa had officially ended the power outage with a leadoff double to right. The extra base hits were the first by the LumberKings since Nick Thurman's two-run double in the ninth inning in Saturday night's loss to the Cedar Rapids Kernels.

This date in baseball history: On this date in 1935, the first-ever scheduled major league night game is rained out in Cincinnati, but the team will face the Phillies tomorrow night. The Reds will play eight evening contests this season, including one against every club in the National League.

The righty turned in seven shutout innings against the Cedar Rapids Kernels, allowing just four hits while walking none and striking out seven. The shutout work makes it 13 straight innings that Romero has not allowed a run to the Kernels. The worked earned him his third win of the season.

AGAINST THE BEES: This will be Romero's first start of his career against the Burlington Bees.
