**Tonight's Starter:** Right-hander Cody Ponce takes the mound to open the Tribe's final homestand. He began the season in Milwaukee's system with Double-A Biloxi before being traded to Pittsburgh on July 29 in exchange for RHP Jordan Lyles. Between Biloxi and Double-A Altoona he went 1-3 with a 3.65 ERA in 30 appearances (1 start).

**Last Outing:** Ponce set season highs last week against Toledo. He fanned eight for the first time since 5/29/17 and went five innings for the first time this season.

**Against the Mud Hens:** Ponce faced Toledo last week in the Tribe's doubleheader at Fifth Third Field. He went five scoreless innings and allowed just two hits. He also fanned a season-high eight batters.

**35:** Ponce became the 35th different player to pitch for the Tribe this season, tying the franchise record of 35 set in 2013. RHP Blake Cederlind's Triple-A debut on August 22 at Toledo later broke the record.

**Miscellaneous:** Traded from MIL to PIT on 7/29/19 in exchange for RHP Jordan Lyles. ... Named a mid-season All-Star in 2017 with Carolina. ... Earned the FSL Pitcher of the Week award on 7/10/16 with Brevard County. ... Selected by MIL in the 2nd round (55th overall) of the 2015 First-Year Player Draft out of Cal Poly Pomona.
