Today's Preview: The Clinton LumberKings (A, Mariners) meet the Bowling Green Hot Rods (A, Rays) for the first and only time this season. In the two teams' only meeting, at Ashford University Field in Clinton, in 2017 the LumberKings won a three-game series, 2-1. The LumberKings trail the all-time series, dating back to 2010, 10 to 13. Since Clinton has been affiliated with the Seattle Mariners (2009) they trail the head-to-head matchups 10 games to 13.

LumberKings Starter: Nick Wells, 22, makes his fifth start of the season for the LumberKings. The lefty took the loss his last time out, in a start that came in Grand Chute against the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers. All of the damage done in the start against Wells was limited to one inning, where he allowed all five of his runs to score. Following the five-run Timber Rattlers rally, the Virginia native set down the final seven batters he faced. He worked four innings, allowing five runs on seven hits while striking out five. A three-year returner with the LumberKings, Wells was the Opening Day starter for Clinton this season and has faced the Hot Rods once in both 2016 and 2017. Over his career he is 0-2 against Bowling Green and has not made it through five innings in each of his previous two starts versus the Hot Rods. Wells came into the Seattle Mariners organization via a trade with the Toronto Blue Jays in which the Mariners traded RHP Mark Lowe to Toronto for LHP Rob Rasmussen, LHP Jacob Brentz and Wells on July 31, 2015

Hot Rods Starter: Drew Strotman, 21, makes his fifth start of the season for the Bowling Green Hot Rods. The righty took a no decision in his last outing, a start against the South Bend Cubs in Bowling Green. Despite not coming away with the win, Strotman threw the ball well. He logged six innings, the second consecutive start he has done that, and allowed just one run on four hits while walking one and striking out four. The Hot Rods Opening Day starter was taken by the Tampa Bay Rays in the fourth round of last years draft out of Saint Mary's. A Bay Area native from Sunnyvale, California is currently ranked as the 23rd best prospect in the Tampa Bay Rays system. He shot up draft boards following a switch from relief to starting while in College and signed with the Rays for \$367,500. He is known for a fastball that tops out at around 97 to 98 MPH and sits 93-95 MPH. Many see him as a future bullpen arm but for now the Rays will give him many innings as a starter.

Last Time Out: Jack Larsen drove in five runs and the Clinton LumberKings dropped the Beloit Snappers 8-5 in a seesaw battle at Harry Pohlman Field on Sunday afternoon. Larsen ended his afternoon going 3-for-5 at the plate with a triple and five RBI. Clinton (14-6) spotted the Snappers (9-9) an early lead in the bottom of the first inning. Beloit tallied three runs against LumberKings starter Ryne Inman. A two out two-run single by Trace Loehr capped the rally for Beloit which gave them a 3-0 lead. The LumberKings broke the tie in the top of the ninth inning against Snappers reliever Heath Bowers. Clinton loaded the bases against Bowers (1-1) with two out in the inning when Larsen cleared the bases with a triple to left center field to give him his fifth RBI of the game. The five RBI performance by Larsen set a new professional career high. Sam Delaplaine (1-0) worked the ninth for Clinton and worked around a one out single and walk by getting Logan Farrar to bounce into a game ending double play.

Best in the West: The LumberKings open the month of May as the best team in the Midwest League and are in first place in the Western Division by 2.5 games over the Burlington Bees. A 14-6 record for Clinton in April gave the LumberKings their best month of baseball since the 2016 team went 19-10 in August. In 2017, it took the LumberKings till August to record their first and only winning month of the year, going 15-14.

Um...Wow: Jack Larsen added to his bases loaded loor on Sunday afternoon in Beloit. The LumberKings outfielder cleared the bases with a triple to give Clinton a come from behind win. He now has 10 RBI with the bases loaded this season and is 3-for-5 (.600) with a double, triple, and home run. He is slugging 1.800 with a LumberKing at every base this season.

First of the Year: It took until before the final game in the month of April but the Clinton LumberKings made their first roster move of the year. Reliever Austin Hutchison earned a promotion to High-A Modesto for an April in which he did not allow a run a body of work of 11.2 innings. In conjunction, the Seattle Mariners assigned Right-hander Scott Boches.

League Leaders: As the LumberKings open the month of May, they bring in several of the Midwest League leaders. Following a road trip that included 13 RBI, Jack Larsen has brought his RBI total to 19 good for second in the league, trailing only Kevin Smith of the Lansing Lugnuts. Ariel Sandoval, despite not hitting a home run over his last 14 games, is still second in the league in long flies with four. Infielder Ryan Costello is second in the league in doubles, 8, and tied for second in extra base hits, 11. On the pitching side, starter Tommy Romero can boast the second highest strikeout per nine inning ratio in the league, 12, and reliever Adonis De La Cruz owns the second lowest walk ratio per nine innings, 0.71, in the league.

Come Back Kids: It took back-to-back come back wins for the LumberKings to take a three-game series from the Beloit Snappers to close out the month of April. In game two of the series, Clinton stormed back from down five, 6-1, to beat Beloit 8-6. In Sunday's win, Clinton roared back from a three-run deficit to drop the Snappers 8-5. Through one month of baseball the LumberKings have not lost a series and are 5-0-2 in series thus far.

Here Comes the East: The Bowling Green Hot Rods make their first and only trip to Clinton this season. The Hot Rods will be followed by the Dayton Dragons in a six-game home stand that features the first matchups with the Eastern Division this season. Due to a quirk in the schedule this will be the first time in LumberKings franchise history where they have hosted the Hot Rods in back-to-back seasons.

This date in baseball history: On this date in 1926, Chattanooga right-hander Satchel Paige makes his professional pitching debut, blanking the New Orleans Algiers, 1-0. The Black Lookouts rookie gives up only two hits in the Negro Southern League contest.

LAST TIME OUT: Wells was given the loss for his last outing, a road start against the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers. The lefty gave up all five of his runs in the bottom of the second inning but settled down to retire the final seven batters he faced. Wells issued two walks while surrendering a season high seven hits and striking out five.

AGAINST THE HOT RODS: This will be Wells first start of the season against the Bowling Green Hot Rods but as a three-year returner has faced the Hot Rods in both 2016 and 2017. In his two previous career starts against Bowling Green, Wells is 0-2. In both starts he went 4.2 innings failing to get through five innings.

2017: Made 25 starts with A Clinton. Along with Ljay Newsome was the only starting pitcher to begin the season in the rotation and end the season in the rotation. Set a professional career high for strikeouts during his first outing of the season. The lefty struck out nine Beloit Snappers at Ashford University Field on April 10th but received a no decision for his work.
