Today's Preview: The Clinton LumberKings (A, Mariners) meet the Beloit Snappers (A, Athletics) for the second time this season with the final game of a three-game series. In the two teams' first meeting this year at Ashford University Field in Clinton, the LumberKings came away with a three-game sweep, their first of the year. The three-game sweep contributed to a seven-game winning streak for Clinton, their longest of the season. The LumberKings trail the all-time series, dating back to 1982, 222 to 258. Since Clinton has been affiliated with the Seattle Mariners (2009) they trail the head-to-head matchups 79 games to 81.

LumberKings Starter: Ryne Inman, 21, makes his fourth start of the season for the LumberKings. He was given the loss in his last outing against the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers. Inman allowed three runs over five innings while surrendering four hits, walking one, and striking out five. This will be the righties first start of the season against the Beloit Snappers but his second of his career. As one of the nine returners from the 2017 LumberKings team, Inman faced the Snappers once before. He made a start at Harry Pohlman on August 10, 2017 and was given the loss for his work as he lasted just 3.2 innings allowing three runs on two hits while walking four and striking out four. A current Beloit Snapper took Inman deep in the outing, Jesus Lopez, who hit solo shot in the 2nd inning of the LumberKings 4-1 loss. Drafted by the Seattle Mariners in the 15th round of the 2015 draft, Inman was stand out stating pitcher at his high school in Parkview Georgia. During his senior season he was a crucial part of his team's high school stat championship, which Inman still refers to as his favorite baseball memory.

Snappers Starter: Jared Poche, 23, makes his third start of the season for the Beloit Snappers. The LSU product is coming off a five-inning outing in which he did not allow a run to the Peoria Chiefs, he held them to a single hit while walking one and striking out five. He needed just 55 pitches to get through his latest outing which stood in contrast to his season debut when he failed to make it through five innings and threw 84 pitches against the Burlington Bees. Over his first 9.3 innings of work this season, Poche has allowed just one run. Twice drafted while pitching at LSU, Poche was first taken by the San Diego Padres in the 14th round of the 2016 draft but did not sign. The Oakland Athletics then took Poche in the 9th round the following season, signed him, and sent him to the Vermont Lake Monster of the New York-Penn League where he made just one outing, a two inning start. His twitter header photo is off himself batting during his collegiate career at LSU.

About Last Night: The Clinton LumberKings stormed back from a five-run deficit on Saturday afternoon at Harry Pohlman Field to drop the Beloit Snappers 8-6. The comeback effort was the largest of the season for Clinton (13-6) who made up the deficit with a five-run top of the seventh inning. The LumberKings spotted the Snappers (9-8) an early four-run lead in the bottom of the first inning. Clinton starter Oliver Jaskie, had all nine Snappers come up to face him in the inning but was let down by his defense. Eugene Helder committed a fielding error to open the flood gates for Beloit who tallied three unearned runs in the inning to break LumberKings streak of 18 games without allowing an unearned run. In the top of the seventh inning, the LumberKings offense exploded against Snappers reliever Joshua Reagan. Nine batters came up in the inning for Clinton, with the first four men reaching. Greifer Andrade smashed his first home run of the season to bring home the LumberKings fourth runs of the inning and pull to within one. Three batters later Billy Cooke worked a two out walk against Reagan forcing him from the game. Chris Castellanos worked two perfect innings out of the LumberKings bullpen following Hutchison and picked up his first win of the season. David Gerber sealed the come from behind win with his first safe of the year, working around a leadoff single to Nick Allen to preserve the 8-6 win.

Jeckvll and Hyde: Oliver Jaskie struggled for the LumberKings in his fourth start of the season for the LumberKings on Saturday afternoon. The lefty lasted just 2.2 innings after allowing a four-run first inning and six runs total. The 2.2 inning outing was the shortest of the season by a Clinton starter. In game one of the road trip, Jaskie set a season high for innings pitched with seven shutout innings against the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers.

And so it Ends: Jack Larsen was one of the few LumberKings to not join in the come from behind win on Saturday afternoon. The LumberKings outfielder went 0-for-5 with three strikeouts and failed to reach base for the first time this season. Larsen ended his stretch of reaching base safely at 17-games, the longest streak by a LumberKing in two years.

For the Win: An early deficit to the Snappers, after a four-run first inning, was made worse when two more runs crossed the plate in the third inning to give Beloit a 6-1 lead. The LumberKings made up all five runs in the top of the seventh inning with a five-run rally to tie the game. Clinton took the lead for good in the top of the eighth with a two-run rally to complete the largest come-from-behind win of the season. The previous largest come from behind was also against Beloit when Clinton overcame a three-run deficit in 5-4 on April 21.

The Draught Ends: A positive sign for the LumberKings offense in Saturday's win was the performance of Ariel Sandoval. A presence in the middle of the order through the first month of the season, Sandoval had gone a week without an extra base hit which came to an end with his triple in the third inning. Even given the draught, he leads the team in extra base hits with 10.

A Month Without Runs: The game on Saturday began to settled down for the LumberKings when Austin Hutchison came in out of the bullpen. The righty dominated in a 3.1 inning outing in which only one hit while one and striking out three. Hutchison, with the shutout work, ran his scoreless inning streak to 11.2 to start the season.

This date in baseball history: On this date in 1913, wearing White Sox uniforms, the Reds are defeated by the Cubs, 7-2, at Chicago's West Side Park. Cincinnati forgot to pack uniforms and had to don those worn by their opponents' crossstown rivals.
