TODAY'S GAME: Game two of a three-game series against the Bradenton Marauders (PIT) from LECOM Park (0-1)...Clearwater is coming off a three-game sweep at the hands of the Florida Fire Frogs (ATL) at Spectrum Field, and a 2-5 homestand against Florida and the Palm Beach Cardinals (STL)...Third of four series (12 games) between the two clubs in 2019...The Threshers took two of three against the Pittsburgh Pirates affiliate in Bradenton to start the second half from June 17-19.

TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER: 23-year-old Connor Seabold makes his second appearance - first start - as a Clearwater Thresher in 2019 in game two of the three-game set against the Bradenton Marauders from LECOM Park on Wednesday morning...The 6-foot-3 hurler earned his first win of the season with a run allowed over four innings against the Palm Beach Cardinals on July 10...The right-hander gave up just two hits - one home run - and struck out five on 53 pitches - 35 strikes...Wednesday will be the Newport Beach, Calif. native's first career start against the Pittsburgh Pirates affiliate.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Clearwater Threshers saw their losing streak stretch to five games after an 8-0 loss to the Bradenton Marauders on Tuesday night...Julian Garcia suffered the loss, allowing three runs - two earned - on four hits, a walk and three strikeouts across six frames of work...Clearwater finished 0-for-2 with runners in scoring position and left seven men on base.

GARCIA'S GRACES: Julian Garcia tossed his fourth consecutive quality start in the series opener against the Marauders on Tuesday night...The right-hander has allowed seven runs - six earned - over his last four starts on 15 hits, seven walks and 20 strikeouts.

SEARCHING FOR RUNS: The Clearwater Threshers were shut out for the third straight game in the 8-0 loss...The Threshers have gone 0-for-17 with runners in scoring position during the stretch, and have not crossed the plate over the last 25 innings.

HOWARD'S HYPE: Spencer Howard continued his dominance of the Florida Fire Frogs on Sunday afternoon...The Philadelphia Phillies fifth-ranked prospect tossed five hitless innings against the Atlanta Braves affiliate, and struck out seven across five innings of work...The only base runner against the right-hander was off a two-out walk to CJ Alexander in the fourth inning...The 22-year-old has started three games against the Fire Frogs in 2019, and has allowed only two run through 14.2 stanzas, while setting down 25 men on strikes compared to just three walks...The performances earned the Cal Poly San Luis Obispo product pitcher of the week for the week of July 8-14.

PILING ON THE PUNCH OUTS: Julian Garcia (3) and Andrew Brown (2) set down five men on strikes, raising the Threshers' staff total to 893 on the season - 53 more than the Fort Myers Miracle (MIN) for the top-spot in the Florida State League.

HOME SWEET HOME?: With the 2-8 start to the month of July, Clearwater continues to stay below .500 with a 22-26 record at Spectrum Field in 2019...The discrepancy in stats between home and road games is not that different for the Threshers...The club has a .258 average at home compared to .239 on the road, and has scored eight more runs (197-189)...Clearwater has a .704 OPS at Spectrum Field, but has posted a .680 on the road...On the mound, the pitching staff does have a higher ERA on the home bump (3.88-3.14), and has a higher average against (.238-.233)...The Threshers have been swept three times this season, with all three coming at home...Clearwater is currently in the midst of a four-game losing streak at Spectrum Field, the second streak of at least four games in the second half in 14 contests.

LEAVING MEN ON BASE: After plating 47 runs through the first seven games of the second half, the Clearwater offense has managed 67 runs the last 21 contests...Over the stretch, Clearwater has managed just a .211 average with a chance to drive a runner home (34-for-161)...The Philadelphia Phillies affiliate has 145 hits over the 21-game stretch, with 48 going for extra bases (33 percent).

NO JUNE SWOON: Everything went the way of the Clearwater Threshers in the month of June, as the club posted a league-best, 18-7 record during the third month of the season...The offense had a dip in production in average (.246 in June to .277 in May), on-base percentage (.310 in June to .326 May) and OPS (.690 in June compared to .737 in May), but excelled in the pitching department...The arms dropped their ERA by more than a point from 3.69 in May down to 2.56 in June, and had 28 less walks with 68 in June compared to 96 in May...The bullpen took a step forward in June as well, going 9-2 and 10-for-11 in save opportunities...Relievers also posted a 1.58 ERA (17er/97.1ip), while collecting 119 strikeouts (one shy of tying April's season-high).
