**DEAL DOWNS JUPITER IN SATURDAY'S GAME ONE, 2-0:** LHP Hayden Deal and the Florida Fire Frogs dodged rain-drops through the final two innings but plowed through to secure a 2-0 victory against the Jupiter Hammerheads in Saturday afternoon's game one of a double header at Roger Dean Chevrolet Stadium. The contest began with a 77-minute delay due to rain in the area and sloppy field conditions. Once the seven-inning game got underway, it elapsed just 92 minutes. Deal (4-9) earned his second complete game of his career and received his first win since June 4 at Fort Myers. He faced 26 batters on Saturday, scattering five hits and a walk with six punch outs while firing an economical 76 pitches, 55 for strikes. Six of the nine Fire Frogs in the order had a hit. Andrew Moritz notched his ahead of Jeffrey Ramos in the sixth, who went deep for the eighth time this season against RHP Cason Sherrod for the only tallies of the ballgame.

**JUPITER JUBILEE:** Second and third games of a six-game road trip for Florida, which will be followed by the Fire Frogs playing 14 of their next 17 games at the Pond. 2nd of 2 meetings this season between the clubs at Roger Dean Chevrolet Stadium with the 1st meeting coming back in May. The Fire Frogs won 2-out-of-3 games to take what would be their only road series win of the season before July 13. 10 of the 13 series games were played in the 1st half. The Fire Frogs are 11-9 in games played against Jupiter at this stadium. Friday's rainout and yesterday's game two postponement were the first two rain-affected games of this season series between the Hammerheads and Fire Frogs.

**DELGADO DIVES ON:** All-Star Riley Delgado struggled early in the month of July but has picked it back up lately. He has gotten on in 84 of the 104 games he has logged a plate appearance and has hits in 72 of those games. He has separate 9-game (4/12-4/22) and 10-game (4/27-5/7) on-base streaks and had a season-best 17-game streak that ended June 11. He holds the second longest away hitting streak in the FSL, recording at least a knock in 15 straight road contests dating back to May 23 at Dunesdin and ending June 29 at Tampa: .325 AVG, 15 RBI, 7 2B, 3B, 10 R, 6 BB, 9 K, .358 OBP. He is actually riding another 5-game road hitting streak entering Sunday's action. Dolly still paces the circuit with 116 hits and is third in the Braves organization behind Rafael Ortega's 120 (Gwinnett) and Drew Waters' 134 (Mississippi) and has more hits and a higher average than Cristian Pache (.278, .109). Delgado hit .223 (21-94) in 25 July ballgames, but has ten hits over his last nine assignments (10x30, averaging .333). He is on a three-game hitting streak and has reached safely in his last seven ballgames.

**RAMBLING RAMOS:** Jeffrey Ramos has gotten back to his usual run-producing ways, including swatting a homer and driving in six runs over his last four games. He is currently on his fourth hitting streak of at least five contests, hitting at a .364 clip (8x22) in his last six assignments. He smoked his first homer since June 1 as part of Saturday's 2-0 shutout victory over Jupiter. Going further back, Ramos has hits in 9 of his last 11 and has reached safely in 10 of those dating back to July 23.

**THE MORITZ POND MASH:** Andrew Moritz has enjoyed the friendly confines of Osceola County Stadium since being called up to the Fire Frogs mid-season, averaging .350 (28x80) with eight multi-hit efforts. He has hits in 18 of his 20 home assignments and is currently on an ten-game home hit streak which is the longest active streak in the FSL. He is hitting just .235 away from home. He hopes to extend his Florida-best seven-game hitting streak today: .370 AVG (10x27), 3 RBIs.

**STARTING OFF RIGHT:** Florida starting pitchers really started to warm up in July, with three straight pitchers capping off the month with quality starts. Over the last seven games, starters have permitted just a 0.84 ERA (4 ER/42.2 IP) going back to game two of last Friday's double header against Daytona. The starters have allowed just four total runs (3 ER) the last 37.2 innings. Taking this back a bit further, seven quality starts have been fired over the previous twelve games and the pitchers have maintained a 2.07 ERA (17 ER/74 IP), this span does include RHP Tristan Beck allowing 6 ER over 5.1 IP on Friday July 26 in game one of the twin bill against Daytona.
