



Position: Summer Hospitality Internship

Summary:

The Wichita Wind Surge Stadium has openings for Summer Hospitality Interns. The Hospitality Intern works directly with the front office. A Hospitality Intern would primarily be focused on making sure our fans have a wonderful experience by providing exceptional service, preparing food and drinks, and helping execute events. Some positions can lead to full-time positions during the internship or to positions within the company at the completion of the internship. Interns will work with the Food and Beverage Department to assist in the management and supervision of all suites and hospitality areas.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities

Include the following. Other duties may be assigned.

- Assisting with day-to-day operations of the concession stands
- Assisting in operations with Suite Level Hospitality
- Assisting with operations on the Miller Lite Party Deck, the Emprise Bank Party Deck, Picnic Area and any other hospitality areas
- Providing exceptional customer service
- Assisting in ordering product for concession stands and hospitality areas
- Working closely with the Director of Food and Beverage on inventory, re-orders, month-end financials, etc.
- Help with day to day function of organization. You may be asked to do any number of things, it is part of the all-inclusive experience

Qualifications

- Must be currently attending a college or university
- Be able to work all game dates, extended hours are required
- Have strong organizational skills
- Have an ability to adapt to a fast-paced, multi-task work environment
- Have superior oral communication, writing and editing skills
- Are highly motivated with strong work ethic
- Have a passion for sports or hospitality and have a strong desire to work in a team environment

Time Frame (April 2020-September 2020):

Interns are expected to begin their internship on April 13, 2020 or as soon as they are done with classes for the spring semester and stay until the end of the season (September 7, 2020) or as soon as they must report for the fall semester. It is expected that interns will work a full work schedule during the summer and work ALL the Wichita Wind Surge home games.

Physical Demands

The physical demands described here are representative of those that must be met by an employee to successfully perform the essential functions of this job. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions.

- Lift and carry 25 pounds up to 50 pounds at a time, perform various activities such as constant standing, walking, frequent bending, reaching, kneeling and squatting
- Ability to stand for up to 8+ hours
- Ability to work long hours, weekends and holidays
- Ability to work in a noisy environment

Hours of Work

- Seasonal position (Mid April- Mid September) with part time (max 30 hours/week) schedule including some long shifts, nights, weekends and holidays.
