In Case You Missed It: The Baysox dropped the second game of the series with Akron by a score of 5-3. The RubberDucks jumped out to an early 4-0 lead in the fourth, but Bowie got a run back in the bottom of that inning on an RBI double from **Preston Palmeiro**. The Baysox other two runs came on solo home runs from **Brett Cumberland** and **Alexis Torres**.

Ring the Wells: **LHP Alex Wells** makes the start for the Baysox today. In his AA debut in Akron last Saturday, Wells pitched 4.2 scoreless innings. Wells made 24 starts in High-A Frederick last year, going 7-8 with a 3.47 ERA. In 2017, Wells won the Jim Palmer Award, given to the best minor league pitcher in the Orioles organization. That year, he went 11-5 with a 2.38 ERA in 140 innings. The 22-year-old was signed by the Orioles in 2015 out of Australia. Wells enters the 2019 season as the 27th ranked prospect in the Orioles system, according to MLB.com.

In the Other Corner: **LHP Sam Hentges** will be making his fifth start of the year for Akron. Hentges has struggled in 2019, coming into this game with an 8.62 ERA in 15.2 innings. The 22-year-old has allowed at least five hits and at least three runs in each of his previous four outings. Hentges was a fourth-round pick of the Indians out of Mounds View High School in Minnesota in 2014.

A Familiar Matchup: The Baysox and RubberDucks are meeting for the second time in a week. Last weekend in Akron, the RubberDucks swept a three-game series from Bowie. Akron won the first game on Thursday night 7-4, and then swept a Saturday doubleheader by scores of 1-0 (F/8) and 2-0.

Scouting the RubberDucks: Akron comes in with a record of 8-11 after losing two of three in their last series against Binghamton. **Andrew Monasterio** is the team's leading hitter, entering the series with a .333 batting average. **Daniel Johnson** is the team leader in home runs (3) and RBIs (14). **Zach Plesac** and **Matt Solter** have led the pitching staff, each with ERA's of 1.02 or better.

Top Tier Talent: The Bowie Baysox roster is filled with some of the top prospects in the Orioles' farm system. According to MLB.com, seven of the top 30 prospects in the organization will begin the season in Bowie. Outfielder **Yusniel Diaz** headlines the roster, coming into the year as Baltimore's number one prospect. Outfielder **Ryan McKenna** (#7) and Left-Handed Pitcher **Zac Lowther** (#8) also rank in the Orioles' top ten. Pitchers **Hunter Harvey** (#12), **Dillon Tate** (#18), **Zach Pop** (#20) and Infielder **Rylan Bannon** (#23) round out the top prospects that start the 2019 campaign with the Baysox.

The Buck Starts Here: 2019 marks Buck Britton's first season as manager of the Bowie Baysox. Britton replaces Gary Kendall, who was the head man in Bowie from 2011-2018. Britton picked up his first victory as a AA manager on April 7 against the Harrisburg Senators. Last season, Britton managed the Delmarva Shorebirds, leading the club to a 68-66 record. Prior to getting into coaching, Britton played nine seasons in Minor League Baseball, and spent parts of 2009, 2011, 2012, 2013 and 2014 with the Baysox. Buck is the brother of former Baysox and Orioles' left-hander Zack Britton.

This Day in Baysox History: On April 27, 2016, the Baysox defeated Richmond by a score of 6-3. In the win, **Chance Sisco** went 2-3 with four RBIs. **Mike Yazstremski** added two hits of his own.

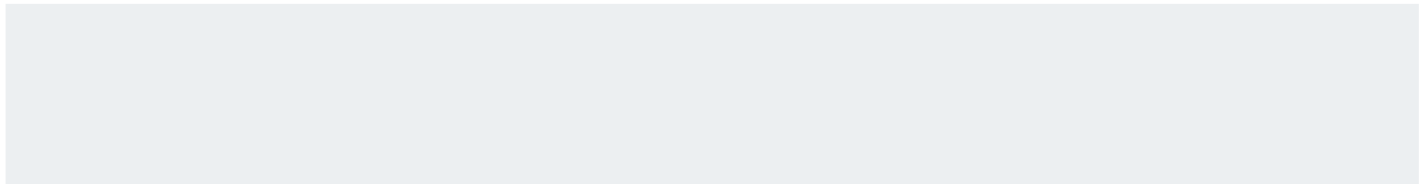
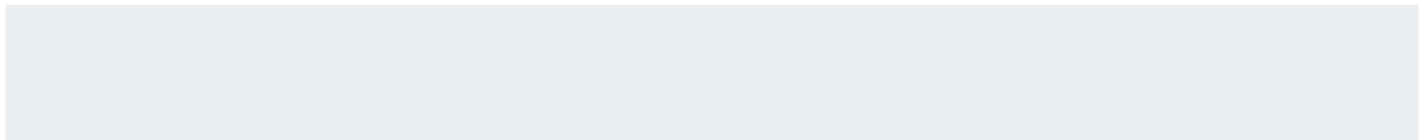
