Today's Preview: The Clinton LumberKings (A, Mariners) meet the Bowling Green Hot Rods (A, Rays) for the first and only time this season with the finale of a three-game series. In the two teams' only meeting, at Ashford University Field in Clinton, in 2017 the LumberKings won a three-game series, 2-1. The LumberKings trail the all-time series, dating back to 2010, 10 to 15. Since Clinton has been affiliated with the Seattle Mariners (2009) they trail the head-to-head matchups 10 games to 15.

LumberKings Starter: Ray Kerr, 23, makes his fourth start of the season for the LumberKings. The lefty has rebounded from a poor season debut with back-to-back strong starts his last times out. He turned in his first quality start of the season against the Beloit Snappers his last time out. Kerr held Beloit to just one run over his six innings of work and scattered six hits while walking none and striking out one. The start marked the second time that he failed to issue a walk. Kerr has missed one start this season due to a blister on his throwing hand. The blister was an issue during his season debut and led to him being skipped the next turn through the rotation. The Seattle Mariners signed Kerr as a Free Agent on August 22, 2017 and had him make his professional debut with the Arizona League Mariners.

Hot Rods Starter: Austin Franklin, 20, makes his fifth start of the season for the Bowling Green Hot Rods. The Florida native was given a no decision for his last outing. Franklin worked five innings against the Lake County Captains and did not allow a run while holding the Captains to four hits and two walks. He set a new season high for strikeout during the outing with seven. The Tampa Bay Rays selected Franklin in the third round of the 2016 MLB Draft out of high school. He jumped up draft boards by throwing two no-hitters in high school and leading his team to a District 1-1A championship. He signed for \$597,500 after being selected in the third round and is still viewed as a bit of project despite ranking as the 14th best prospect in the Rays organization, according to MLB Pipeline. Still thought of as a starter, Franklin's fastball regularly sits in the low 90's but will occasionally touch 95 with heavy sink. Still, his 11-to-5 curveball, with late bite, is considered by scouts to be his best pitch. Coming into the 2018 season the Rays are hoping to see a more refined changeup while also improving upon his control.

Last Time Out: Clinton LumberKings pitching imploded against the Bowling Green Hot Rods on Wednesday afternoon at Ashford University Field in a 10-5 loss. Clinton (14-8) pitching combined to set season highs in walks, 11, and hits allowed, 18, in the second most lopsided loss of the season. The Hot Rods (14-11) jumped on LumberKings starter Tommy Romero early. In the top of the first inning, Bowling Green batted around to score three runs to take a lead they would not relinquish. Romero (2-2) turned in the shortest start by a LumberKing starting pitcher this season and was knocked out of the game after just two innings. He allowed four runs during his time out on seven hits while walking two and striking out three. Despite being out-hit by 11, the LumberKings offense had a fine day at the plate. A Jack Larsen RBI double in the first inning opened the scoring for Clinton. The LumberKings added a run in the fifth on Johnny Adams third home run of the season, a solo shot to left, and scored twice in the second and once in the eighth for a five-run day that could not keep pace with the Hot Rods offensive avalanche. The only LumberKings pitcher in the game to not allow a run was position player Louis Boyd who recorded the final three outs in his professional pitching debut.

He Pitches: The LumberKings pitching staff came into Wednesday's matinee with the lowest ERA in the Midwest League. By the end of the day they had allowed 10 runs, all earned, to balloon their team ERA to 3.33 now third in the league. It also took five pitchers to get through the game, most used this season, including infielder Louis Boyd. Boyd was actually the only pitcher to be used that did not allow a run. He surrendered a leadoff single and no more while also striking out the final batter he faced.

New Lows: Wednesday's 10-5 drubbing by the Bowling Green Hot Rods set several new lows for LumberKings pitching. Four pitchers combined to issue 11 walks, a new season high, and the pitching staff surrendered 18 hits, the most this season in a single game. The start turned in by Tommy Romero, just two innings, was also the shortest of the season.

Not a Warm Reception: Clinton LumberKings fans made their displeasure known regarding the adoption of Minor League Baseball's rule for extra innings. In the first LumberKings extra inning game of the season, fans saw for the first time each extra half inning begin with a runner at second base. They booed in the top of the tenth when the rule was announced, placing a Hot Rod at second, and they booed in the bottom of the inning when again the rule was announced placing a LumberKing at second.

Hail to the Chief: Johnny Adams hit his third home run of the season in Wednesday afternoon's loss. The long fly had ended a stretch of 10 games without a home run for Adams and went as the team's 19th. The LumberKings sit second in the league, as a team, in home runs. Trailing only the Lansing Lugnuts with 23.

Early Risers: Wednesday marked the penultimate 11 AM game of the season for the LumberKings. The mid-week matinee coincided with the final Kids' day of the season. The LumberKings will play their final 11 AM home game of the year on July 16 against the Lansing Lugnuts.

Here Comes the East: The Bowling Green Hot Rods make their first and only trip to Clinton this season. The Hot Rods will be followed by the Dayton Dragons in a six-game home stand that features the first matchups with the Eastern Division this season. Due to a quirk in the schedule this will be the first time in LumberKings franchise history where they have hosted the Hot Rods in back-to-back seasons.

This date in baseball history: On this date in 1980, Willie McCovey homers for the final time, a solo shot off Scott Sanderson in the fourth inning of the Giants' 3-2 loss to Montreal at Olympic Stadium. The 42 year-old future Hall of Fame first baseman, who hit the first of his 521 round-trippers in 1959, joins Red Sox legend Ted Williams as the only other major leaguer to homer in four different decades.
