Information

Getting Started:

Groups interested in doing an organization of the night have the opportunity to do the following:

- Sell Fundraising Tickets for General Admission Section
 - Tickets are pre-purchased with a **minimum of at least 50 tickets**
 - Tickets will be bought from the River Bandits at a price point of \$4 and can be sold for \$8 by the organization to the general public
- Earn different promotional opportunities from the River Bandits including:
 - First Pitch
 - Pre-Game Interview
 - Concourse Table
 - Donated River Bandits Raffle Item
 - Dunk Tank

Information Needed from Organization of the Night

The below information is needed, as applicable to each organization of the night, at least 72 hours before the scheduled game date.

First Pitch

- The name of the person throwing out your first pitch
 - Individual must report to the Guest Services desk on the third-base side of the concourse shortly after gates open
 - Gates open 1 hour prior to scheduled game start time

Pre-Game Interview

- The name of the person who will be interviewed on-field pregame about the organization
 - Individual must report to the Guest Services desk on the third-base side of the concourse shortly after gates open
 - If you would like your logo on the video board during your interview or have a 30 second video to be played, you will need to get that to the River Bandits no later than 48 hours before your game day.

Concourse Table

- The number of tables and volunteers manning table
 - One six-foot table will be provided
 - Please ask if you need more, we will determine availability in a case by case manner
 - Maximum 5 volunteers, chairs will be provided
- A raffle or silent auction is permitted, but NO 50/50 is allowed at the organization's table or in the stadium
 - Organization is responsible for informing winners
 - We recommend collecting phone numbers or email addresses to reach winners
- You are welcome to hand out any information or promotional items for your organization that you would like to from your table

Raffle Item

- Once this level is reached, we will put together some items or one large item, at the River Bandits discretion, to be used in the raffle/silent auction at the organization's table

Dunk Tank

- If your organization earns to use the dunk tank, there are several things to address:
 - Organization provides change for purchases
 - Recommended to have \$75-\$100 for change in small bills
 - Organization provides individual to be dunked
 - Organization provides 1-3 volunteers to sell baseballs and monitor dunk tank
 - **THERE MUST ALWAYS BE A VOLUNTEER WATCHING THE TANK**
 - Baseballs are provided by River Bandits
 - When you finish with the dunk tank, please inform a River Bandits staff member so the tank can be drained prior to leaving it unattended

For Your Information:

The below information is necessary in ensuring a smooth, successful Organization of the Night. Please take the time to read in detail.

Complimentary Tickets for Volunteers

- You will be given, at most, 5 complimentary general admission tickets for your volunteers to use for the game. These will be printed out and given to you at the time you pick up your fundraising tickets.

Day of Game Information

- Gates to the ballpark will open to the public one hour before the scheduled start time (e.g. If game time is 6:35, gates open at 5:35)
- Your organization is welcome to come in through the suites entrance an additional 15 minutes before gates open to go up to the concourse and get settled at your table.
 - Each person who enters through the suite entrance will need to have their ticket scanned at that point in time
 - The person who scans your tickets will either instruct you how to get upstairs, or will radio your representative to come and meet you

Reporting of Funds Raised at Stadium

The River Bandits ask that your organization report the total amount raised from the event held at the ballpark; including dunk tank proceeds, silent auctions/raffles, and ticket sales.
