Today's Preview: The Clinton LumberKings (A, Mariners) meet the Kane County Cougars (A, Diamondbacks) for the second time this season with the second game of a five-game series. The teams opened the season and saw their first two games (in Kane County) snowed and colded out. Forcing the teams to play a doubleheader on April 8th at Ashford University Field. The LumberKings took two of the first three meetings between the teams. The LumberKings trail the all-time series, dating back to 1991, 163 to 176. Since Clinton has been affiliated with the Seattle Mariners (2009) they trail in the head-to-head matchups 63 games to 74.

LumberKings Starter: Ray Kerr, 23, makes his 11th appearance and start of the season for the Clinton LumberKings. The California native took the loss his last time out for a four-inning outing against the Peoria Chiefs at Ashford University Field. He allowed three runs, only one earned, while surrendering four hits, walking none, and striking out four. Kerr did not face the Cougars over the season opening series in Clinton back in April. The lefty has been with Clinton since Opening Day and missed only one of his starts this year. In his season debut against the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers he lasted just three innings, being hit hard, and was removed from the game as a blister had developed on his pitching hand forcing him to miss his next start. An avid fisherman, Kerr has been fishing since he can remember and says if he were not in baseball he would be a professional fisherman.

Cougars Starter: Jayson McKinley, 24, makes his seventh appearance and second start of the season for the Kane County Cougars. The Texas native received a no decision his last time out, working one inning of relief against the Peoria Chiefs, not allowing a run while walking one and striking out three. McKinley made a string of three starts from May 1 through May 31 with the High-A Visalia Rawhide and Double-A Jackson Generals. McKinley was originally signed as a nondrafted free agent with the Tampa Bay Rays and spent all of his 2017 season with the Bowling Green Hot Rods before being cut and then signed by the Arizona Diamondbacks on February 2, 2018. He attended Lamar University where graduated in 2016 with a degree in Mechanical Engineering. In addition to continuing his professional baseball career, he has used his degree to work in several engineering positions and is currently employed by BMW Constructors in Pasadena, Texas.

Last Time Out: Clay Chandler threw a professional career-high seven innings, and the Clinton LumberKings dropped the Kane County Cougars 6-2 on Friday night at Ashford University Field. Eugene Helder found himself in the majority of the LumberKings (34-26) rallies with a 2-for-2 night at the plate where he scored three runs, walked twice, doubled, and homered. The first half of the contest seesawed back and forth with the Cougars (30-29) scoring the game's first run on the top of the second. The LumberKings answered right back with a run in the bottom of the second to tie the game at one. Kane County starter Mack Lemieux issued a pair of one out walks to Helder and Dimas Ojeda and Ryan Scott singled through the left side of the infield for Clinton's first run of the night. The LumberKings put the game out of reach with a three-run rally in the bottom of the eighth inning. Billy Cooke plated the first run with a sacrifice fly to right with the bases loaded and Ryan Scott followed with a two-run single to right center field, his third RBI of the night. Collin Kober worked the final two innings for Clinton and did not allow a Cougar to reach against him while striking out two and earning his second save of the season.

Keeping Pace While Gaining Ground: A win by the LumberKings on Friday night had them keep pace with the Peoria Chiefs in the Western Division to remain a half game back of first. The Chiefs took their series opener with the Quad Cities River Bandits for their 8th win over their last 10 games. Were the season to end today, Clinton would be the wild card team in the Western Division. The LumberKings currently lead the River Bandits by 2 and ½ games for the Wild Card spot and own a magic number of 8 to clinch.

Sandoval Heating Up: Ariel Sandoval sees Cougars left-hander Mack Lemieux very well. Evidenced by his 3-for-6 line that includes two runs scored, a double, a home run, and two RBI over two games against the lefty. The success at the plate has risen his average to .256 on the season a nearly 40 point spike since his average had dipped to .219 following an 0-for-4 in Peoria on May 16.

Don't Call It a Comeback: Eugene Helder returned to the LumberKings starting lineup after missing three straight starts in Burlington during a brief three-game road trip with the Bees. The LumberKings regular third basemen, made just one pinch-hit appearance in Burlington, but returned to the starting lineup on Friday night. The Aruba native went 2-for-2 at the plate with three runs scored, a double, a home run, and two walks to pace the Clinton offense.

New Heights: Friday night's win over the Kane County Cougars marked a few new professional career highs for LumberKings players. Clay Chandler started for Clinton and logged seven innings to set a new high-water mark for innings pitched. Chandler then struck out eight batters during his time out to set a new professional career high for Ks. Ryan Scott found himself in the middle of several LumberKings rallies and tallied three RBIs to set a new career high for runs driven in. Scott has been playing professional baseball since 2013.

LumberKings All-Stars: The All-Star announcements are here and the Clinton LumberKings will be a well-represented team in Lansing on June 19th. Jack Larsen will start for the Western Division All-Stars while teammate Ryan Costello will come off the bench. Pitchers Ryne Inman and Collin Kober will represent Clinton and come out of the bullpen. All four of the LumberKings representatives will be making their first all-star game appearances of their professional career.
