**CARDS CASH IN EARLY:** The Palm Beach Cardinals took the set opener from the Fire Frogs, 4-2, on Tuesday. Scott Hurst and Nolan Gorman went deep early. Lars Nootbaar added a run-producing double. That was all the Cardinals offense could muster, as LHP Philip Pfeifer, RHP Lukas Young, and RHP Brooks Wilson set down 21 batters in a row to finish the game. Pfeifer surrendered six hits and four runs in six innings. Logan Brown was one of three Fire Frogs who had two hits, he drove in a run in the third. Drew Lugbauer slapped an RBI single for the second straight game.

**DELGADO DIGS IN:** The efficiency in which All-Star Riley Delgado has reached base is startling. He has gotten on in 59 of the 71 games he has logged a plate appearance and has hits in 52 of those games. He has separate 9-game (4/12-4/22) and 10-game (4/27-5/7) on-base streaks and was on a season-best 17-game streak going into the Dunedin series on June 11. Delly went 2x4 in what was his 26th multi-hit game of the season. Delgado is also swatting .387 (12x31) over his past seven games after breaking out of an 0x12 slump early last week.

**FROGS AND CARDS CLASH:** After St. Lucie took the final three of the series against Florida, they won the series to force a 1-3 start to the seven-game home stand for the Fire Frogs. The Cardinals have come to town for the second and final time this season. Florida still has to play six games later in the season at Roger Dean Chevrolet Stadium. The Fire Frogs are 6-10 against the Cardinals at Osceola County Stadium. They won 22-2 over the Cardinals in the first matchup played here on April 25, 2017 but proceeded to go 1-4 at the Pond against the Cardinals affiliate the rest of the year. Palm Beach went 7-5 versus Florida last year, including a season-series clinching 16-10 win on August 8.

**HAMMERING HARRIS:** The former 32nd Round selection out of Missouri became the first Florida player this season to hit home runs in three-consecutive games with his solo shot in the 1st on Thursday. Harris went 1x4 on Tuesday to move his on-base streak to 8. He has hits in 11 of his first 16 games at Advanced-A. The SAL Mid-Season All-Star has combined to slash .358/.429/.581 with 11 HR, 52 RBI, 93 H, 17 2B, 4 3B, and 5 SB between Low-A Rome and Florida.

**OPPOSING STARTER:** RHP Perry DellaValle is ready to make his 15th start of the season and second against the Fire Frogs. He received the nod and tossed the first inning of a game that was suspended on 6/1 and picked back up on 6/2 at the Pond: L, IP, 4 H, 2 ER, HR, 0 K. His last start was at Dunedin (6/20): ND, 5 IP, 5 H, 3 ER, HR, 3 BB, 2 K, PC: 75/45. He has yielded a homer in his last four starts and has allowed five this season, a team-high. He gave up only 11 ER through his first 9 starts (52.2 IP, 1.88 ERA) but has given up 11 ER over his last 5 starts (20.1 IP, 4.87 ERA). He was a 27th Round pick of St. Louis in 2018 out of D-II Seton Hill University in Greensburg, PA. Was 7-6 with a 3.35 ERA in 75.1 IP as a Senior with the Griffins program. From North Royalton, OH and attended Brecksville Broadview Heights HS.

**JEFREY JUMPS ABOARD:** The 20-year-old slugger has rebounded nicely from an 0x18 slump he was suffering through at the beginning of the Daytona series last Monday. He has climbed aboard in nine straight games, with hits in four straight entering play tonight. Ramos went 1x4 in Tuesday's loss to Palm Beach.

**Today's Start:** The southpaw makes his team-leading 14th start of the season. This will be his 55th career appearance and 19th start. This will be his first start of his career against Palm Beach.

**Last Start:** Deal allowed a career-high 10 hits and a season-high 3 earned runs over 5.2 innings with a walk and six strikeouts while taking his second-straight loss on Friday evening (6/21) vs. St. Lucie. He has now given up multiple earned runs in four of his last five starts after allowing multiple earned runs in just one of his first eight starts. The southpaw has struggled in the month of June, going 1-2 with a 4.26 ERA in three starts (12.2 IP) and has a 1.66 WHIP and a .346 BAA against. His opposing batting average against is currently at a season-high .229.

**Notes:** Deal was lights out for the Rome Braves last season, 9-1 record, 2.17 ERA, 27 G (5 starts), 78.2 IP, 62 H, 17 BB, 82 K... With his performance, he was named Rome's Pitcher of the Year by the Braves organization... His wins were the second-most in the Braves system and his ERA was second-lowest among Atlanta farmhands with at least 75 innings thrown... His 4.82 strikeout-to-walk ratio was second in the organization in 2018... He was undrafted out of a small DI school (Presbyterian) in South Carolina... Royals said their Minor League roster was full, hence Billy Best and the Braves were able to sign him instead on June 23rd, 2017... Led the Big South conference in appearances (31) out of the bullpen during 2016 season and finished a league-high 26... Held opponents to a .242 BAA in 2015 while making 29 appearances, beat Clemson on April 1st... Played baseball for four years at Bandys HS in Catawba, N.C... his father also was in athletics there.
