Working Overtime: Last night it took 11 innings for the Brewers to beat the Oream Owlz, but Pablo Abreu's walk off sacrifice fly got the job done, as Helena downed Orem 5-4 in 11 innings. It marked the second extra inning game in the seven game home stand, as Helena played 11 innings against Grand Junction on August 17th (8-7 loss). The Brewers are now 4-2 in extra frames and have six walk

Tonight's Duel: Max Lazar returns to the hill after picking up his second win on Saturday against Grand Junction with five innings of one run baseball. He will be making his fourth start of the year against Billings, having completed five innings with two or less runs on his line. Righty Adrian Rodriguez goes for Billings, making his second start against Helena. In his lone start against the Brewers, he got a no decision with three runs allowed on seven hits in six innings.

All The Stars Are Golden: Four Helena Brewers made the 2018 Pioneer League All Star Team, which played against the Northwest League All Star Team on August 7th. LG Castillo and David Fry were starters in left field and catcher respectively, while Chad McClanahan came off the bench and Wilfred Salaman out of the bullpen. Fry went 1 for 2 with an RBI, while Castillo went 2 for 5. Salaman pitched a scoreless inning out of the bullpen.

Home Cookin: Helena will now play 7 of their next 10 games at Kindrick Legion Field. The Brewers play seven straight at home after this three game trip to

Where They Stand: The Brewers trail Billings by 3 games for first place in the Northern division. They have three games left this season against the Mustangs.

Abreu Loves A Grand Salami: On the last road trip Pablo Abreu hit grand slams in two different games, with both slams giving the Brewers the lead. Abreu had 12 RBI on the road trip.

Oh Look Who It Is: Brewers 2018 1st Round selection Brice Turang was promoted to Helena prior to August 1st's game and went 3 for 4 with three singles in his Helena debut on August 1st. He has hit safely in all eight games he has played in Helena. The former LSU commit hit .319 in 13 games in the AZL. His father Brian played parts of two seasons in the majors with the Seattle Mariners. He has four sisters that all played college athletics.

David Fry, Road Warrior: All but three of David Fry's home runs in 2018 have come on the road. He has 12 RBI on the road in 13 second half games. Fry on August 14th had a 16 game hitting streak & a 21 game on base streak snapped. Both were the longest by a Brewer in 2018. He leads rhe Brewers in batting average, home runs, and RBI.

Brewer Prospecting: Three players on Helena's current roster are currently ranked in MLB Pipeline's top 30 Brewers prospects. Shortstop Brice Turang is 4th, while pitcher Caden Lemons is ranked 15th. Outfielder Je'Von Ward is ranked 26th. Ward, a former USC commit, is the nephew of former NFL safety Mark Carrier, who also played at USC.

Matching Up With The Mustangs: Billings enters this three game series against the Brewers with the best record in the second half. Undrafted free agent Dylan Harris is hitting .417 against Helena in nine games with 11 RBI.

**Meet Max:** Max Lazar starts his 2018 season in Helena after spending his debut season in the Arizona League. An 11th round selection in the 2017 draft, Lazar turned down a scholarship offer with Florida Atlantic University in order to sign with the Brewers.

**Last Start:** Lazar after almost a two month hiatus picked up his second win of the season with five innings of one run baseball on Saturday against Grand Junction. He faced the minimum through his first three innings and stranded four runners on base in his final two.

**The First Win:** Lazar was good again on June 22nd against Billings, allowing just one run on five hits in 5.1 innings. The only run that score against him was allowed by Austin Rubick, who entered the game with the bases loaded and one out in the sixth. Lazar faced the minimum through four innings and surrendered just one extra base hit.

**Endurance:** Lazar has completed at least five innings in eight of his 11 starts. The three starts in which he did not get into the fifth all came against Southern division opponents.

**History With Billings:** Lazar will be making his fourth start of the season tonight against the Mustangs, but it will be his first at Dehler Park. He has gone at least five in all of his starts against Billings and has not allowed more than two runs.

**Controlling The Zone:** Lazar last season did not issue a walk in each of his first six appearances in 2017. He also struck out at least three in each of those appearances.

**What The Scouts Say:** According to Baseball Census, scouts who covered Lazar in the AZL last season compliment his arm speed and his side to side command. His arm strength is advanced for his age, and he enjoys challenging hitters.

**Award Season:** For his performance against Great Falls on June 15th, Lazar was named the MiLB Pitcher of the Week by Jewish Baseball News.

#### Manager - Nestor Corredor (3rd Season)

Nestor Corredor, 34, returns to Helena to manage the Brewers for a third season in 2018. Corredor played seven professional Minor League seasons in the Brewers organization from 2002-2008, hitting .211 with 10 HR and 109 RBI in 332 games. This will be his fifth overall season in Helena after playing for the team as a catcher in 2004, returning as a pitcher in 2008 and managing the team in 2016 & 2017. Over the course of his managerial career, Corredor has compiled a record of 224-300 (.427) in eight seasons spent with the Rookie Dominican Summer League Brewers (2010-2012), AZL Brewers (2013-2015) and Helena Brewers (2016-2017).



## Pitching Coach - Rolando Valles (2nd Straight Season, 4th Overall)

Rolando Valles, 38, returns to Helena for his second consecutive season. Valles served as Helena's pitching coach in 2014-2015 under Tony Diggs and worked as a Latin Liaison for the Brewers from 2008-2013. In 2016 he was the pitching coach for the AZL Brewers. An undrafted free agent in 1997 by the Houston Astros, Valles played seven seasons of minor league and independent league ball from 2000-2007, going 43-26 with a 3.72 ERA in 189 appearances, 73 of them starts.



### Hitting Coach - Liu Rodriguez (3rd Season)

Liu Rodríguez, 41, returns to the Brewers organization for his fifth season and his third year in Helena. In 2015, Rodríguez served as a coach for Class-A Wisconsin, and in 2014 he worked with the Rookie Arizona Brewers. A former middle infielder, Rodríguez spent seven seasons in the White Sox organization from 1995 to 2001, making his Major League debut in 1999. The native of Caracas, Venezuela batted .237 with 1 HR and 12 RBI in 39 career Major League Games.



## Bullpen Coach - Jim Henderson (1st Season)

Former MLB pitcher Jim Henderson joins Helena as their bullpen coach for the 2018 season, his first as a professional coach. A Calgary, Alberta native, Henderson was a 26th round selection by the Expos in 2003, and made his major league debut with Milwaukee in 2012. His final season in the big leagues was in 2016 when he made 44 appearances with the New York Mets.



## Athletic Trainer - Matt Deal (2nd Season)

Matt Deal, 25, starts his fourth season in the Brewers organization and second in Helena. A native of Evergreen Park, IL, Deal attended Marquette University and graduated with a degree in Athletic Training in 2015. He was hired by the Brewers in 2015 and spent his first summer in the Dominican Republic with the Dominican Summer League Brewers. In 2016, Deal moved back stateside and worked for the AZL Brewers as the teams' athletic trainer.



## Strength & Conditioning Specialist - Lucas Weitzel (1st Season)

Lucas Weitzel, 23, comes to the Brewers from the University of Florida, where he earned a BS in applied physiology & kinesiology and a MS in human performance. During his time at UF, he worked with the baseball, softball, football, track & field, swimming & diving, and volleyball teams. His father Brad, is currently the bench coach for the University of Florida, and has been in baseball for 39 years, most notably with the Minnesota Twins, as he signed and/or drafted 19 future big leaguers in 16 years as the Twins' Florida area scout.
