Today's Preview: The Clinton LumberKings (A, Mariners) meet the Peoria Chiefs (A, Cardinals) for the first time this season with the opener of a three game-set. In the team's first meeting this year, the Chiefs took three out of four from the LumberKings over a four-game stretch at Dozer Park in Peoria. Clinton avoided being swept in the four-game set with a 7-2 win on May 17. Still the LumberKings could have had a split of the series had it had not been a Chiefs come from behind win 7-5 on May 16, a game which Clinton led at one point 5-0. The LumberKings lead the all-time series, dating back to 1983, 239 to 214. Since Clinton has been affiliated with the Seattle Mariners (2009) they lead in the head-to-head matchups 78 games to 55.

LumberKings Starter: Nick Wells, 22, makes his 11th appearance and start of the season for the Clinton LumberKings. The Virginia native turned in the best start of his professional career his last time out. Despite taking the loss, Wells turned in his first complete game as a professional and his 7.2 inning outing at Cedar Rapids is the longest of his career. The lefty allowed three runs, two earned, on seven hits while walking one and striking out four. This will be his second start of the season against the Peoria Chiefs. He prevented a sweep at the hands of the Chiefs with a six inning start in which he allowed only one run on six hits while walking three and striking out five. Wells has now gone six innings or more in his last three outings, just the second time in his career he has done so. As a result, he leads the team in innings pitched. The LumberKings Opening Day starter is in his third season in Clinton. He was originally drafted by the Toronto Blue Jays in the third round of the 2014 MLB Draft before being traded to the Mariners as part of a four-player trade on the trade deadline in 2015.

Chiefs Starter: Alvaro Seijas, 19, makes his 10th appearance and eighth start of the season for the Peoria Chiefs. The Venezuelan native took the loss his last time out for a 5.1 inning outing in which he allowed five runs, four earned, to the Quad Cities River Bandits at Modern Woodman Park. He set a season high by issuing five walks, also hitting a batter, while striking out one. This will be his second start of the season against the LumberKings and was hit hard. Failing to get through the fourth Seijas lasted just 3.2 innings while surrendering nine hits and leading to five runs. The righty works with a fastball that ranges between 91-95 MPH to work off a curveball and changeup. During his season in the Appalachian League in 2017 he posted an incredibly high BABIP of .393. He currently is labeled as the 17th best prospect in the Cardinals organization according to MLB Pipeline.

Last Time Out: The Clinton LumberKings moved back into first place in the Western Division with a 5-2 win over the Quad Cities River Bandits on Thursday night at Ashford University Field. The win marks the third consecutive series win for Clinton (30-23) who end the month of April with their 30th win of the season. Quad Cities (30-24) claimed an early lead against the LumberKings. Ryne Inman pitched for Clinton and surrendered the game's first run in the top of the second inning. A leadoff walk to Jake Adams started the frame and turned into a run on a wild pitch and RBI single by Colton Shaver. The lead for the River Bandits did not hold up for long as Clinton rallied for four runs in the bottom of the second inning. The LumberKings tallied just one hit in the inning sending 10 men to the plate in the game's deciding rally. Three errors were committed by River Bandits infielders and two walks by Quad Cities starter Yohan Ramirez forced him from the game in an abbreviated 1.2 inning start. Inman (3-2) earned the win for Clinton with a five-inning outing in which he allowed one run to Quad Cities on four hits while walking one and striking out six. Scott Boches worked the final two innings for Clinton and surrendered the final run of the night in the top of the eighth. After hitting the first batter he faced and surrendering a single to Jonathan Arauz, Boches settled down to hold the River Bandits to a Miguelangel Sierra RBI ground out. In the ninth, Boches struck out two and retired Michael Papierski on a fly out to center to end the game and move Clinton back into first place.

Here Come the Chiefs: After taking two of three from the Quad Cities River Bandits to jump back into first place, the Clinton LumberKings continue their battle to retain the top spot in the Western Division by opening a three-game set with the Peoria Chiefs, a team now tied with the River Bandits for second place.

Costello Goes Deep: The final run of the night for the LumberKings came via a big fly from first baseman Ryan Costello. The solo home run in the third inning of Thursday night's win just hooked fair down the line in right for his team leading eighth home run of the season, tying him for fourth in the Midwest League in home runs. The clout upped his RBI total to 38, the most among any minor leaguer in the Mariners organization and the third most in the league.

More Costello: The LumberKings have combined to hit seven home runs over their last 10 games, three of which have come from Ryan Costello. The LumberKings first baseman has combined to hit .303 (10/33) with 12 RBI over his last game and he is the only LumberKing to be batting over 300 over the last ten games.

Success with Righties: This series will feature three right-handed throwing pitchers for the Peoria Chiefs. The success at the plate for Clinton this season has primarily come against righties. As a team they are batting .246 with 33 home runs and 223 runs scored while hitting .214 with just five home runs and just 27 runs scored against left-handed pitching.

This date in baseball history: On this date in 1964, the exhibition game with their Williamsport farm club is rained out, much to the delight of the Mets. Yesterday, the team finished a ten-hour marathon at 11:25 p.m., dropping a twin bill to the Giants, 5-3 and 8-6, which included a 23-inning nightcap.

LAST TIME OUT: Wells made it three straight quality starts his last time out. In his first complete game of his career, Wells set a new a professional career high for innings pitched, 7.2. Still the lefty was hung with the loss as the Kernels came from behind to walk-off Clinton. He allowed three runs on seven hits while walking one and striking out four.

AGAINST THE CHIEFS: This will be Wells second start of the season against the Peoria Chiefs, earning the win in Peoria on May 17 in Peoria. Wells turned in the first of three consecutive quality start. He held the Chiefs to one run on six hits while walking three and striking out five. The LumberKings batter back Wells with seven runs of support and cruised to a 7-2 series finale win.

2017: Made 25 starts with A Clinton. Along with Ljay Newsome was the only starting pitcher to begin the season in the rotation and end the season in the rotation. Set a professional career high for strikeouts during his first outing of the season. The lefty struck out nine Beloit Snappers at Ashford University Field on April 10th but received a no decision for his work.
