TODAY'S GAME: The M-Braves continue their opening homestand at Trustmark Park with game two of a five-game series against the Mobile BayBears (LAA). Atlanta Braves' No. 3 prospect Ian Anderson will face off against LA Angels' No. 25 prospect Jeremy Beasley.

M The Mississippi Braves are 4-7 in home openers all-time, including 1-1 against the BayBears. The M-Braves opened the 2012 and 2013 seasons against the BayBears at Trustmark Park.

LAST TIME OUT: The Braves dropped Thursday night's game two of the series to Mobile, 7-5, losing a 4-1 lead in the fifth inning when Mobile scored six runs during the top of the fifth. Ian Anderson made the start and gave up two earned runs over 4.1 innings in a no-decision. The Braves scored four of their five runs in the third inning. RF Cristian Pache was 1-for-2 with a triple and two RBI. CF Drew Waters finished 1-for-4 with an RBI and walk, pushing his hitting streak to four games.

PACHE'S HOT START: OF Cristian Pache has hit in five of six games so far, batting .280 (7-for-25) with two triples, three doubles and seven RBI.

M Pache currently is tied for the league lead with five extra-base hits and seven RBI.

HURSH NEARING ANOTHER CAREER RECORD: RHP Jason Hursh is already the M-Braves career leader in wins (17), innings (321.1), starts (41) and strikeouts (208). He's currently second in appearances, just one behind Mark Lamm at 113.

MULLER TIME: Atlanta's No. 13 prospect according to MLB.com, Kyle Muller his second start of 2019 and first career start against the BayBears in game three of the five-game set.

M Muller made his 2019 debut on day two of the 2019 season and took a no decision after reaching his pitch limit. Over 3.2 innings, Muller gave up just one hit, no runs, while walking four and striking out four. He threw 78 pitches. The M-Braves picked up their first win of the year, 4-3 at Smokies Stadium.

THIRD-MOST TALENTED TEAM IN MILB: MLB Pipeline ranked all 120 full season Minor League teams to open the season and the M-Braves roster ranked as the No. 3 most talented team in MiLB. Triple-A Gwinnett was ranked fifth.

150 HOMERS AND COUNTING: INF Andy Wilkins hit his first home run as a Brave on Friday night, his 150th in the minor leagues. Wilkins hit one major league home run in 2016 for Milwaukee.

HIT ME WITH YOUR BEST SHOT: INF Ray-Patrick Diddy was hit by a pitch for the 101st time in his career on Wednesday. Over 530 games, Diddy has been plunked more than anyone in minor league baseball over the past eight seasons.

OPENING DAY ROSTER: The M-Braves Opening Day roster has 25 active players and three on the injured list to begin the season.

M Overall the initial roster has 14 players returning to Mississippi from 2018, 13 that were drafted by the Braves, four minor league free agents, four non-drafted free agents, three acquired via trade and one selected in the Rule 5 draft.

M The roster contains four with MLB experience (Jonathan Aro, Jason Hursh, Ben Rowen, Andy Wilkins), seven countries represented (United States, Dominican Republic, Venezuela, Aruba, Columbia, Mexico and the U.S. territory of Puerto Rico)

M Nine top 30 prospects according to MLB.com (Ian Anderson (3), Cristian Pache (4), Drew Waters (8), Joey Wentz (12), Kyle Muller (13), Patrick Weigel (19), Tucker Davidson (22), C.J Alexander (23) and Ray-Patrick Diddy (30)...three top 100 prospects in baseball according to MLB.com (Anderson (32), Pache (36) and Waters (84)).

M The roster contains five players that are 21-years-old, or younger to begin the season. OF Drew Waters is the youngest (20, 12/30/98), followed by OF Cristian Pache (20, 11/19/98), RHP Ian Anderson (20, 5/2/98), LHP Joey Wentz (21, 10/6/97) and LHP Kyle Muller (21, 10/7/97).

2018 SEASON

- Made 25 starts between Single-A Rome, High-A Florida and Double-A Mississippi, and went 11-3 with a 3.03 ERA (47 ER/139.2 IP).
- Led the Atlanta system with 11 wins and ranked second in innings pitched (139.2), eighth in starter's ERA (3.03) and eighth in strikeouts (129).
- Earned three Pitcher of the Month awards from the organization, including April at Rome (2-0, 1.90 ERA, five games), June at Florida (3-0, 2.43 ERA, five games) and August at Mississippi (4-1, 3.10 ERA, five starts).
- Pitched in seven games with Peoria of the Arizona Fall League following the season, and went 1-0 with a 2.53 ERA (3 ER/10.2 IP) out of the bullpen.

2017 SEASON

- Played his first full professional season with rookie-level Danville, going 1-1 with a 4.15 ERA (22 ER/47.2 IP) and 49 strikeouts over 11 games, all starts.
- Allowed two or fewer earned runs in eight of his 11 starts. Entered the season tabbed by MLB.com as Atlanta's No. 13 prospect, while Baseball America named him No. 17.

2016 SEASON

- Played his first professional season with the GCL Braves and earned the club's Pitcher of the Year honors.
- Closed his rookie campaign as the 11th-best prospect in the Gulf Coast League as named by Baseball America.

PERSONAL

- Earned 2016 Gatorade National Player of the Year honors after pitching to a perfect 8-0 record with a 0.46 ERA and 133 strikeouts in 76.0 innings at Jesuit College Prep.
- Entered the First-Year Player Draft as the 25th-best player in the class according to Baseball America.
- Jesuit won the 6A final over San Antonio Johnson, less than a week later, he signed with the Braves...Since the award's inception, Muller was just the fourth winner from a Texas high school, joining Todd Van Poppel (1990), Jason Stokes (2000), Clayton Kershaw (2006) and last year's winner, Luken Baker (2015).
- He set a national high school record by striking out 24 consecutive batters across two starts, including the first 18 batters of the game as part of an eight-inning, 21-strikeout performance. Muller also set a record by recording 36 consecutive outs on strikeouts at one point.
- Hit .396 with 15 home runs and 52 RBI and was projected as a third or fourth round draft choice as a first baseman, but played outfield in high school.
- Committed to play baseball at the University of Texas, but opted to sign with the Braves.
