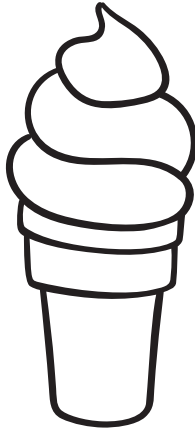

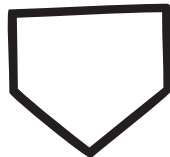

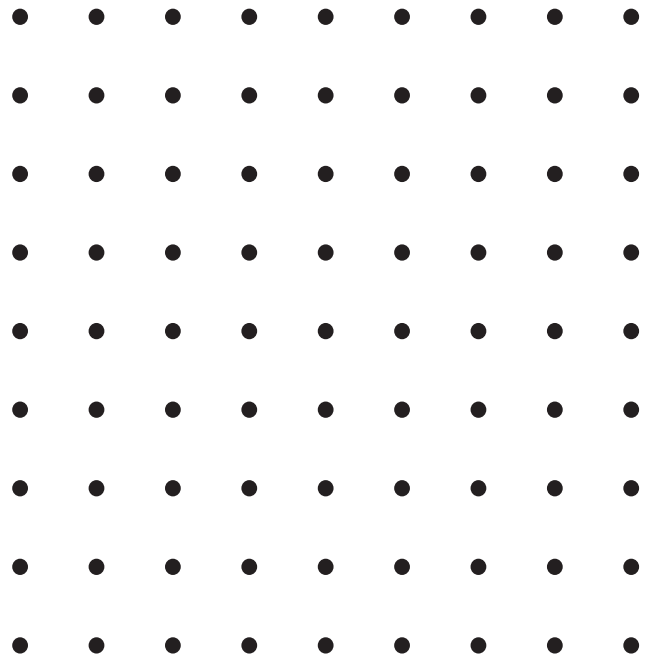


# DOTS & BOXES!

This is a game for two or more people.

1. To start the game, take turns drawing one horizontal or vertical line between two dots that are next to each other, connecting them together anywhere.
2. If you complete a full square, write your initial in the box and take another turn. If your line creates or completes two boxes at the same time, then you get to put your initial in both of them.
3. Continue playing until all the dots on the page are connected and all boxes are completed.
4. Count how many boxes each player has on the page. The player with the most boxes wins!

Strategy will be involved to see if you can create more boxes than your opponent. Try not to let them complete a box before you!
