Today's Preview: The Clinton LumberKings (A, Mariners) meet the Beloit Snappers (A, Athletics) for the second time this season with the second game of a three-game series. In the two teams' first meeting this year at Ashford University Field in Clinton, the LumberKings came away with a three-game sweep, their first of the year. The three-game sweep contributed to a seven-game winning streak for Clinton, their longest of the season. The LumberKings trail the all-time series, dating back to 1982, 221 to 258. Since Clinton has been affiliated with the Seattle Mariners (2009) they trail the head-to-head matchups 78 games to 81.

LumberKings Starter: Oliver Jaskie, 22, makes his fourth start of the season for the LumberKings. The lefty opened the road trip for Clinton with a seven-inning shutout performance against the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers to run the LumberKings winning streak to seven games. Jaskie benefited from four double play balls during his time out, the most turned by the LumberKings in a game in over three years. He earned the win for his time out, his first with the LumberKings, and his seven innings are still the most thrown by a Clinton pitcher this season. The Seattle Mariners selected Jaskie in the 6th round of the 2017 MLB Draft out of the University of Michigan where he was teammates with 2017 LumberKing Johnny Slater. Coming into the 2018 season, the Michigan native was ranked by *Baseball America* as the 21st best prospect in the Mariners system, the highest ranked prospect on the current LumberKings roster.

Snappers Starter: Xavier Altamirano, 23, makes his third start of the season for the Beloit Snappers. The Douglas Arizona native, did not face the LumberKings when the Snappers came to Clinton April 20-22 but did face them twice during the 2017 season. In his last outing, Altamirano was given a no decision for a five-inning outing against the Peoria Chiefs in which he did not allow a run on just one hit while walking one, hitting a batter, and striking out two. It took him just 65 pitches to get through his five innings, which stood in contrast to his season debut where he threw 80 pitches and failed to get through five-innings; lasting 4.2 innings against the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers. Altamirano was drafted in the 27th round of the 2015 MLB Draft by the Oakland Athletics out of Oral Roberts. He turned heads in high school with remarkably performances such as throwing three no-hitters and recording a 19-strikeout game. When he was not on the mound, Altamirano was on the court where he lettered in basketball and won his team's MVP award three years in a row.

About Last Night: The Clinton LumberKings could muster just one run against Beloit Snappers pitching in a 2-1 loss at Harry Pohlman Field on Friday night. A Matt Clancy wild pitch in the bottom of the eighth inning proved to be the difference in the series opening loss. It took until the top of the third inning for the LumberKings (12-6) to tally their first hits of the night. Three consecutive hits off Snappers (9-7) starter Jean Ruiz pushed across Clinton's first, and only, run of the night. Louis Boyd singled with one out in the inning and scored all the way from first when Ryan Scott doubled down the line at third. The RBI was Scott's fourth of the season and his third to come against Ruiz. Wyatt Marks relieved Snappers starter, Ruiz, and picked up the win. Marks (3-1) went the rest of the way for Beloit not allowing a run over his 4.2 inning outing in which he walked one and struck out nine.

Since the Beginning: Jack Larsen added to his team leading streak of reaching base safely on Friday night. Larsen went 1-for-4 with a walk to make it 16 straight games of reaching base safely, or every game he has appeared in this season.

Nothing for Free: LumberKings pitching staff has combined to allow 52 runs through the first 18 games of the season. The LumberKings have had 12 games this season without committing an error. All of the runs LumberKings pitching has allowed to this point this season have been earned. The LumberKings are now the only remaining team in all of professional baseball, at any level, to have not allowed an unearned to this season.

Just in Time: Friday night's 2-1 loss to Beloit was a quick affair. It took just 2 hours and 11 minutes to finish, making it the quickest nine inning game of the season for Clinton by one minute. The previous quickest game times of 2 hours and 12 minutes was also played against the Beloit Snappers, a 5-1 win on Sunday, April 22 at Ashford University Field.

A Second Time for Everything: Friday night's loss to the Beloit Snappers marked just the second time this season that the LumberKings were out. Clinton tallied just five hits compared to the Snappers nine. When being out this season the LumberKings are 0-2. Despite outlasting their opponents in 16 of their first 18 games, the LumberKing are hitting just .245 as a team and rank 10th in batting in the Midwest League.

Golden Sombrero, again: One night after LumberKings outfielder Greifer Andrade set a new season high for strikeouts in a single game with four K's, Ariel Sandoval followed with a four-strikeout night of his own in the series opener with Beloit. Sandoval went 0-for-4 with the four strikeouts to match a career high for K's in a single game. Sandoval last struck out four times in the same game on May 29 of last season while playing in the California League with the Rancho Cucamonga Quakes.

I Thought this was Over With: While the LumberKings and Snappers played in a timely 2 hours and 11 minutes on Friday night, in Quad Cities, the River Bandits and Cedar Rapids Kernels took 4 hours and 26 minutes to play a 13-inning game that had five runs scored in the extra frames. The 13-inning game is the longest in the Midwest League this season after rules were implemented for extra inning games to speed up the conclusion.

This date in baseball history: On this date in 2012, Bryce Harper makes his much-anticipated debut in the Nationals' 4-3 loss to Los Angeles at Chavez Ravine. The 19 year-old rookie center fielder, who drives in the potential go-ahead run in the ninth inning with a sacrifice fly, doubles in the top of the seventh off Chad Billingsley for his first major league hit.
