**Today's Preview:** The Clinton LumberKings (A, Mariners) meet the West Michigan Whitecaps (A, Tigers) for the first and only time this season with the second game of a three-game series. In the two teams' only meeting, at Fifth Third Ballpark in Comstock Park, Michigan in 2017 the LumberKings lost a three-game series, 1-2. The LumberKings trail the all-time series, dating back to 1994, 58 to 87. Since Clinton has been affiliated with the Seattle Mariners (2009) they trail the head-to-head matchups 15 games to 16.

**LumberKings Starter:** Ray Kerr, 23, makes his fifth start of the season for the LumberKings. They lefty was hit very hard his last time out and managed to record just one out against the Bowling Green Hot Rods who jumped out to score five runs on four hits in a lopsided LumberKings loss. Kerr was given the loss for his abbreviated start which was the shortest of the season by a LumberKings pitcher. The California native was strong in his previous two starts, turning in a quality start on April 27<sup>th</sup> against the Beloit Snappers at Harry Pohlman Field and throwing four perfect innings against the Snappers at Ashford University Field on April 22. Kerr's best pitch is his cutter which he will lean on when in trouble. The Seattle Mariners signed Kerr as an undrafted free agent on August 17<sup>th</sup> of 2017 out of Lassen Community College. His first professional career start was his LumberKings season debut on April 9<sup>th</sup>. Kerr is an avid fisher and has said if he was not playing baseball he would be a fisherman.

**Whitecaps Starter:** Elvin Rodriguez, 20, makes his fifth start of the season for the West Michigan Whitecaps. He earned the win his last time out for a 5.2 inning outing against the Peoria Chiefs in Peoria. Rodriguez allowed a season high eight hits but held the Chiefs to four runs while walking three and striking out five. The Dominican native has faced the LumberKings twice before in 2017 while pitching in the Angles organization with the Burlington Bees. He made his Low-A debut against Clinton at Community Field on August 28, 2017 and took the loss for a five-inning outing in which he held the LumberKings to one run, unearned, on seven hits while walking none and striking six. Rodriguez was promoted to the Burlington Bees on August 19 of last season after going an impressive 5-1 with a 2.51 ERA in the Pioneer League with the Orem Owlz. The impressive first half in the Angels short-A affiliate earned him an all-star game selection and Rodriguez was selected to be the starting pitcher for the Pioneer League, despite throwing a scoreless first inning the Northwest League would go on to win the game 5-4. The Angels signed him as an international free agent in 2015 and assigned to pitch in the Dominican Summer League (DSL) that season. Rodriguez spent two seasons in the DSL before making his state side debut on July 22 with the Arizona League Angels. He was traded to the Detroit Tigers on September 15, 2017 shortly after his season had ended with the Bees.

**Last Time Out:** The Clinton LumberKings picked up their first extra inning win of the season on Monday night at Fifth Third Ballpark with an 8-7, 10-inning, win over the West Michigan Whitecaps. The scoring started immediately for Clinton (16-11) as Joseph Rosa took the third pitch of the game out to right for his second home run of the season. The Whitecaps (17-14) answered the run in the bottom of the fourth to start a string of five straight innings where they put up at least one run. The run in the fourth was the only run allowed by LumberKings starter Tommy Romero over his four innings of work. Five walks issued by Romero forced him from the game after just four innings. Kyle Wilcox (1-0) worked around West Michigan's free runner in the 10th with strikeouts of Valdez and Alexis Garcia to end the game and give Clinton their first extra inning win with the new extra inning rules in effect. The night marked several season highs. Clinton set a new season high for runners left on base, 15, and for longest game time, 3 hours and 52 minutes.

**Are they Paid by the Hour?:** Monday night's win over the West Michigan Whitecaps was on pace to be the longest nine-inning game of the season, instead the Whitecaps came from behind to force extra innings, making the contest the longest game of the season period. It took nearly four hours, 3 hour and 52 minutes, to finish the game beating the next longest game time by the LumberKings by over an hour!

**A First Time for Everything:** The Clinton LumberKings saw a barrage of hits by the Whitecaps on Monday night. The 15 hits surrendered, where the second most allowed by LumberKings pitching this season and dwarfed the Clinton hit total of eight. Still the LumberKings overcame the disparity in hits to drop West Michigan 8-7, marking the first time this season that the LumberKings have been out-hit and still went on to win.

**A Second Time for Everything:** Monday marked just the second extra inning game of the season for Clinton. In their first taste of the new Minor League extra inning rule the LumberKings dropped a ten-inning game to the Bowling Green Hot Rods at Ashford University Field where fans booed the new rule in both the top and bottom of the 10<sup>th</sup>. On Monday they picked up their first bonus baseball win of the season against the West Michigan Whitecaps.

**That was Quick:** Joseph Rosa wasted no time in getting the LumberKings on the board. On the third pitch of the game, the LumberKings infielder slugged his second home run of the season out to right. The long fly was also the first time in 2018 that the LumberKings have leadoff a game with a home. Rayder Ascanio, now with the Peoria Chiefs, was the last to leadoff a game with a home run when he did it two games in a row in 2017.

**Walk-A-Thon:** One season for the slow pace to Monday night's game was a plethora of walks. The LumberKings drew the most walks all season, 12, but were also liberal in issuing free passes as well. Tommy Romero, the starter for Clinton, set a new professional career high for walks issued, five, and LumberKings pitching combined to issue nine walks bringing the walk total between the two team to 21.

**In First Again:** The Clinton LumberKings ran their road winning streak to three games with Monday night's 8-7 ten inning win. The win, in combination with losses by the Cedar Rapids Kernels and Quad Cities River Bandits, puts Clinton back in first on their own to start play on Tuesday.

**This date in baseball history:** On this date in 1961, the New York Metropolitan Baseball Club, Inc. announces the New York National League franchise's team nickname will be the Mets. Other names considered included the Avengers, Burros (a play on the word boroughs), Continentals, Islanders, Jets, Rebels, Skyliners, and the Meadowlarks, which was the first choice of owner Joan Payson.
