**Today's Preview:** The Clinton LumberKings (A, Mariners) meet the Cedar Rapids Kernels (A, Twins) for the second time this season with the second game of a three game-set. This will be the Kernels first visit to Clinton in 2018, the teams played just one of their scheduled three-game series in Cedar Rapids April 13 through April 15 due to poor weather. The LumberKings trail the all-time series, dating back to 1963, 432 to 462. Since Clinton has been affiliated with the Seattle Mariners (2009) they trail the head-to-head matchups 68 games to 84.

**LumberKings Starter:** Ray Kerr, 23, makes his seventh start of the season for the LumberKings. The Sacramento native took the loss his last time out for an abbreviated 2.2 inning outing against the Peoria Chiefs in Peoria. The lefty allowed three runs on two hits while walking four and striking out one. Kerr has had some short starts this season, three times working three innings or less including the shortest by a LumberKings starter this season a 0.1 inning outing against the Bowling Green Hot Rods. He has turned in quality a start this season in addition to a four-inning outing against the Beloit Snappers in which he worked four innings and set down all 12 Snappers he faced. Kerr was signed by the Seattle Mariners as a non-drafted free agent out of Lassen Community College. A life long fisherman Kerr has said if he were not playing baseball he would be a fisherman.

**Kernels Starter:** Bryan Sammons, 23, makes his seventh appearance and start of the season for the Cedar Rapids Kernels. The North Carolina native received a no decision for a 5.1 inning outing against the Bowling Green Hot Rods in Bowling Green. He held one of the strongest offensive teams in the Midwest League to just one run on five hits while walking three and striking out four. In the two teams' only meeting before this series, Sammons faced Clinton and was hung with the loss for a 5.1 outing in which he allowed one run on four hits while striking out three and walking three. He finished the 2017 season with the Kernels but did not face the LumberKings during the Kernels post season run. The 6'4" lefty taken by the Minnesota Twins out of Western Carolina in the 8th round of the 2017 MLB Draft.

**Last Time Out:** Tommy Romero turned in seven shutout innings, and the Clinton LumberKings held off a late Cedar Rapids Kernels push to take the series opener 7-6 on Friday night at Ashford University Field. LumberKings (21-16) batters combined to collect 14 hits for the second highest tally of the season. Romero (3-2) turned in his strongest start as a LumberKing, holding the Kernels (17-19) scoreless over his seven innings of work. The righty scattered four hits during his time out while walking none and striking out seven to earn his third win of the season. The game remained a scoreless tie through four innings with Cedar Rapids starter Blayne Enlow navigating jams over his 4.1 innings out. The game remained 7-0 until the top of the eighth. Collin Kober came on in relief for starter Romero and immediately found himself in trouble when Trey Cabbage led the inning off with a triple into the right field corner. The Kernels sent 10 men to the plate in the inning to score six runs and pull to within one. It was not until Kyle Wilcox entered with the possible tying run at second that Clinton exited the monster inning with a strikeout of Cabbage. Wilcox stayed on to work the ninth, ending the game with back-to-bac strikeouts to earn his first save of the season.

**Refreshing Length:** A quality start by Tommy Romero on Friday night was his second of the season, both coming against Cedar Rapids. The quality start gives the LumberKings back-to-back quality starts for the first time this season. Romero threw seven shutout innings to tie Oliver Jaskie for the longest start of the season by a LumberKing starter.

**Hits on Hits on Hits:** Friday's win featured 14 hits by LumberKings batters, the second most in a game this season. Joseph Rosa, Eugene Helder, Ariel Sandoval, Jack Larsen, Dimas Ojeda, and Billy Cooke, each had multi hit nights with Sandoval recording three hits in his second straight game. The game also gives the LumberKings back-to-back 10-hit nights making it now 14 games that Clinton has registered 10 hits or more this season.

**U-G-L-Y:** Something is in the air for LumberKings pitching in the eighth inning lately. A 7-0 lead was nearly erased on Friday night by a Kernels rally where 10 men came to the plate. The outburst by the Kernels lead to six runs, tying the mark for most runs allowed in a single inning. Three games ago in Peoria, it was the eighth inning in which the LumberKings coughed up a 5-2 lead when they allowed six runs to the Chiefs in the frame.

**Redemption:** In the six-run rally allowed in Peoria to the Chiefs, LumberKings reliever Kyle Wilcox allowed all of the runs to be hung with a loss, his first of the year, and a blown save, also his first. On Friday night it was Wilcox to the rescue as spelt Collin Kober to record the final four outs and pick up his first save of the season. Wilcox entered the game with the potential tying run on second when he struck out Trey Cabbage to stop the bleeding and preserve the LumberKings lead.

**Ojeda Tops the Charts:** Dimas Ojeda made it two days in a row with two hits or more to raise his batting average to .369 the fourth best batting average in the Midwest League. The LumberKings outfielder leads the team in multi-hit games with 12.

**End of a Streak:** The longest hitting streak of the season by a LumberKing came to an end during Friday night's win over the Cedar Rapids Kernels. Johnny Adams took an 0-for-5 night at the plate during the 7-6 LumberKings win and was just one of two LumberKings batters to not collect a hit. The 11-game hitting streak by Adams was the only hitting streak of the season to be 10-games or longer. The LumberKings shortstop batted .419 or 18-for-43 during the streak. The hit streak became the longest of the season by a LumberKing when Adams passed Greifer Andrade's nine game streak that started the season running from April 7<sup>th</sup> to April 22<sup>nd</sup>.

**This date in baseball history:** On this date in 1941, Lefty Grove wins his twentieth consecutive game at Fenway Park, the longest home-park streak in the big leagues. The southpaw starter establishes the new record when the Red Sox beat Detroit, 4-2.
