TRIBE TIPS

LAST NIGHT: The Tribe suffered a 3-1 loss in 10 innings to the Bats on Saturday night. Louisville used a Blake Trahan two-out, two-run single in the top of the 10th to seal the series win and set up an opportunity for a series sweep this afternoon. Christian Colon reached base five times (three singles, one double, one HBP) for the visitors. The Tribe struck out 22 times at the plate and only had five hits, two going as Jake Elmore doubles. Indy scored its lone run in the sixth to answer one run by Louisville in the top half. Gregory Polanco drove in Elmore from second with a double of his own to the right field wall. Rookie Davis (5.2ip, 1er, 6k) and Lucas Sims (5.2ip, 1er, 13k) dueled into the sixth inning before the contest became a battle of the bullpens.

TODAY: The Indians and Bats conclude their three-game series with a matinee affair on Easter Sunday at 1:35 p.m. The Tribe will send righty Mitch Keller (1-0, 3.86) to the bump for his team-high fourth start of the season. He will square off against right-hander Keury Mella (1-1, 7.53). The 25-year-old Mella made his Triple-A debut against Indy back on Sept. 5, 2016 and threw 7.0 innings of one-run ball. He walked one and struck out six in that game. The Tribe saw Mella once last year on Aug. 24 at Louisville Slugger Field, and he threw 2.0 shutout innings while striking out one.

SUNDAY SWEEP: For a third consecutive Sunday, the Indians are finishing a series with a sweep on the line. In their first four-game set of the season at Columbus, the Tribe avoided being swept with a four-run rally in the ninth to win 5-2. Last Sunday against Charlotte the Indians were seeking a four-game sweep of the Knights, but Dylan Cease outdueled Rookie Davis to give the visitors a 3-0 shutout. Today the Bats seek a three-game sweep over Indy. The Tribe haven't been swept in a series since dropping two games in Louisville on Aug. 24-25, 2018. Indy hasn't suffered a three-game sweep since Aug. 10-12, 2018 when Pawtucket won all three games of a set at Victory Field.

TUCKER'S BIG DEBUT: Shortstop Cole Tucker, 22, was recalled by the Pirates yesterday for his first major league call-up. The Phoenix, Ariz. native and 2014 first-round pick by Pittsburgh didn't disappoint with family and friends in attendance, belting a tiebreaking two-run homer in the bottom of the fifth off Giants left-hander Derek Holland. The game was called due to rain after a length delay, making Tucker's 431-foot blast to dead center the game-winner. He finished 1-for-3.

REYNOLDS GETS HIS KNOCK: Outfielder Bryan Reynolds, 24, had his contract selected by the Pirates yesterday and got the nod in center field, batting fifth. He struck out in his first plate appearance on three pitches but drove a single into left field his second time up for his first major league hit. Reynolds and Tucker accounted for half of Pittsburgh's four hits on the day.

ELMORE EXCELLENT: Jake Elmore started at shortstop and led off in last night's game. The 31-year-old journeyman went 2-for-5 with a pair of doubles and a run scored. Through 13 games, the Arizona State product is batting .413 (19-for-46) with five doubles, seven RBI, six runs scored and a team-high seven multi-hit games. He ranks among IL leaders in average (2nd), OBP (4th, .451) and base hits (T-4th, 19).

FELIZ FEELIN' IT: Michael Feliz inherited a first-and-third, no-out jam in the eighth inning last night and managed to keep the Bats off the board. He struck out Nick Longhi, retired Juan Graterol on a foul popout to first and struck out Rob Refsnyder looking to end the frame. Since allowing a run in the eighth inning on April 5 at Columbus, the 25-year-old thrown 7.0 consecutive scoreless innings, surrendering five hits and three walks with 10 punchouts.

SCORE FOUR-PLUS: The Indians have scored four or more runs in 12 of their 15 games so far this season, going 9-3 in those affairs. Since the beginning of the 2017 season, the Tribe are 138-43 (.762) when scoring four-plus runs and 23-93 (.198) when scoring three or less.

WILL POWER: Will Craig contributed a two-run double in the seventh inning Monday night, giving him a team-high five games with two or more RBI. No other Indians player has more than two multi-RBI games. Craig is tied for third in the league with 14 RBI and is tied for the league lead in home runs with six.

Today's Starter: Right-hander Mitch Keller will make his fourth start of the season today as Indianapolis looks to close the 10-game homestand with a win. Keller entered the 2019 campaign rated as Pittsburgh's No. 1 prospect by both *Baseball America* and MLB.com, MLB.com's No. 4 right-handed pitching prospect and a consensus top-30 overall prospect. He was selected in the second round (64th overall) of the 2014 First-Year Player Draft.

This Spring: In Bradenton, Keller went 0-1 with a 22.50 ERA (10er/4.0ip) in three games (two starts). He allowed 10 hits and three home runs with three walks and one strikeout.

Last Outing: Keller pitched into the sixth inning for the first time this season last Tuesday against Toledo, allowing one earned run on seven hits over 5.1 innings of work. He walked four, struck out five and bested Beau Burrows in a 4-3 Tribe victory.

Against the Bats: Three of Keller's 10 starts for the Tribe in 2018 came against Louisville, and he went 1-1 with a 4.58 ERA (9er/17.2ip) in those starts combined. Keller's second career Triple-A start was against the Bats at Victory Field on July 5, and he struck out 10 over 6.0 innings pitched but gave up five runs to take the loss. He beat the Bats on Aug. 26 with another 6.0-inning performance, allowing three unearned runs while striking out six.

Miscellaneous: Keller was most recently selected to the Futures Game in 2018 and started for the U.S. Team, throwing one scoreless inning. He was named Eastern League Postseason Most Valuable Player in 2017, leading the Curve to an EL Title, and was named to the 2017 All-Prospect Team in the Arizona Fall League after a successful stint with the Glendale Desert Dogs. He won the South Atlantic League's Most Outstanding Pitcher Award in 2016 with Single-A West Virginia. The right-hander was named Iowa's best prospect by *Baseball America* prior to the 2014 draft, and he posted a 1.72 ERA in his senior year at Xavier High School in Cedar Rapids. Keller's older brother, Jon, was chosen by Baltimore in the 22nd round of the 2013 First-Year Player Draft and played five seasons in the minors (2013-17).
