RAIN RAIN GO AWAY: The Fire Frogs and Marauders were unable to begin a five-game series over four days yesterday due to rain and unplayable field conditions. Yesterday marks the 10th home date of the 2019 season lost to rain. There have been 9 postponements, 1 suspension, and 1 cancelled game (6/13 vs. Dunedin) at Osceola County Stadium this season. 4 of the 8 home series so far in the second half have featured at least one rainout. For the second time this season, Florida will play back-to-back home double headers to makeup for Monday before finishing the series with Bradenton at noon on Thursday. The Frogs played an entire four game series in less than 24 hours (31 innings) vs. St. Lucie on May 15 and 16.

LAST TIME OUT: HARTMAN HAMMERS THROUGH NINE ON SUNDAY: RHP Matt Hartman navigated around some early Lakeland runs to go the distance for the first time in his career, but the Flying Tigers pitching staff shut down the Fire Frogs bats in a 3-1 series-clinching triumph at the Pond. For the second time in the last eight days, a Fire Frogs pitcher threw the entire game. LHP Hayden Deal tossed a seven-inning complete game shutout last Saturday on August 3 at Jupiter. On Sunday, it was Hartman who surrendered seven hits and three earned runs with five strikeouts mixed in over nine innings. He threw a career-high 106 pitches, 69 for strikes, and retired the last 16 batters he faced to polish off the contest. Kevin Josephina paced a Fire Frogs offense that could only muster three hits against the Lakeland staff on Sunday. He reached base twice, notching a lead-off two-bagger in the third and later scoring on a passed ball during Jordan Rodgers at-bat to cut the deficit to 2-1 at that time. RHP Tom de Blok (1-11) exercised some demons, beating Florida for the first time in four tries and earning his first victory. He allowed three hits and an unearned run over six innings. RHP Angel DeJesus followed with two scoreless stanzas. RHP Billy Lescher put the game on ice with a 1-2-3 ninth to secure his second save.

FIRE FROGS AND MARAUDERS MINGLE: The Fire Frogs and Marauders begin their 8-game season series on the 4th of July, having played 17 prior games over the past two seasons. Florida is 5-6 at LECOM Park, having split a four-game series in 2017 and 2018. The Fire Frogs are 4-5 at the Pond against the Marauders, only playing five of eight scheduled games at the Pond last year with numerous postponements and three cancellations. Florida did get all four scheduled home games with Bradenton in 2017 but did have to play one doubleheader.

DELGADO DIVES ON: All-Star Riley Delgado has gotten on in 89 of the 112 games he has logged a plate appearance and has hits in 78 of those games. He has separate 9-game (4/12-4/22) and 10-game (4/27-5/7) on-base streaks and had a season-best 17-game streak that ended June 11. He holds the second longest away hitting streak in the FSL, recording at least a knock in 15 straight road contests dating back to May 23 at Dunedin and ending June 29 at Tampa: .325 AVG, 15 RBI, 7 2B, 3B, 10 R, 6 BB, 9 K, .358 OBP. Dolly still paces the circuit with 122 hits and is 3rd in the Braves organization behind the 123 hits of Rafael Ortega with Gwinnett and trailing Drew Waters' 142 (Mississippi and Gwinnett) and has more hits and a higher average than Cristian Pache (.275, 114). Delgado hit .223 (21-94) in 25 July ballgames. He is coming off of a slow series against the Flying Tigers where he went 1x13.

THE MORITZ POND MASH: Andrew Moritz has enjoyed the friendly confines of the Pond since being called up to the Fire Frogs mid-season, averaging .360 (32x89) with nine multi-hit efforts. He has hits in 20 of his 22 home assignments and is currently on a twelve-game home hit streak, the longest active streak in the FSL. He is hitting just .205 away from home.

STARTING OFF RIGHT: Florida starting pitchers really started to warm up in July with three straight pitchers capping off the month with quality starts. Over the last 16 games, starters have permitted just a 2.16 ERA (23 ER/96.0 IP) going back to game two of a Friday (7/26) twin bill against Daytona. Taking this back further, 11 quality starts have been fired over the previous 21 games and the pitchers have maintained a 2.54 ERA (36 ER/127.1 IP), this span does include RHP Tristan Beck allowing 6 ER over 5.1 IP on Friday July 26 in game one of the twin bill against Daytona and RHP Freddy Tarnok permitting 5 ER Sunday in game one vs. Jupiter. Tarnok came up one out short of earning a quality start Saturday night vs. Lakeland.

COMPLETE GAME KINGS: Florida fired its ninth complete game Sunday when Matt Hartman went the distance. This total is three more than any other team in Minor League Baseball, besting the Double-A Jackson Generals of the Southern League who have six to their name. The Cleveland Indians lead Major League Baseball with five complete games.

Tonight's Start: The righty makes his 9th start of the season (12th appearance). This will be his 72nd career appearance and 62nd start. This will be his first start against the Marauders and 2nd appearance. The first time he pitched in a game for the Fire Frogs was on 8/6/2017 at the Pond. He threw 2.1 relief innings against Bradenton: ND, 3 H, ER, 2 BB, 3 K, PC: 52/32.

Last Start: 8/4 at Jupiter (was first appearance since coming back from the IL): 2 IP, 1 H, 1 ER, 2 BB, 1 K, PC: 40/28. His last appearance was Thursday (8/8) at the Pond vs. Lakeland: 3 IP, 1 H, 0 R, 0 BB, 4 K, PC: 39/26. Has permitted 2 ER over last 3 GM (7.1 IP) with FLO.

Notes: Withrow missed 2018 to injury (right shoulder impingement syndrome, required surgery), made first appearance since 9/3/17 on May 3rd vs. Tampa: W, 3.1 IP, 2 H, 0 R, 3 K, PC: 49/33. Was on the IL from 6/30-8/1 of this season, missing 28 games.

2017: Appeared in 10 games for the Mississippi Braves (AA)...Went 1-3 with a 4.47era (24er/48.1ip) with 22 walks and 44 strikeouts...Placed on the 7-Day disabled list on 6/7...Assigned to GCL Braves for rehab assignment on 6/28...Tossed five scoreless frames at the GCL level, picking up five strikeouts...Transferred to the Florida on 8/7.

2016: Played the entirety of his second professional season with High-A Carolina and went 9-6 with a 3.80 ERA (51 ER/120.2 IP) and 131 strikeouts in 25 games (24 starts) to earn the Mudcats' Pitcher of the Year honors from the organization...Paced Carolina in wins (9) and led all Mudcats starters with a 3.80 ERA (51 ER/120.2 IP), while his 131 strikeouts on the season were second most in the Carolina League and fifth most among Braves farmhands...Also ranked in the Top 10 among Atlanta prospects in wins (T3rd, 9), starters ERA (8th, 3.80) and innings (10th, 120.2)...Surrendered 3 or fewer earned runs in 21 of his 25 games, and aside from a 3.0-inning start in which he gave up 11 runs on 7/23, he pitched to a 3.06 ERA...Earned his first pro W in his 4th start of the season on 5/1 (vs. LYN)... Fanned career-best 11 in his final start of the season, 8/31 vs. Wilmington.

2015: Made his professional debut with rookie-level Danville after being selected by the Braves in the sixth round of the 2015 June free agent draft...Allowed two earned runs or fewer in 12 of his 13 starts...Pitched primarily in relief during his junior season at Texas Tech and turned in a career-best 3.63 ERA (9 ER/22.1 IP) over 13 games (1 start).
