**Today's Preview:** The LumberKings (A, Marlins) are back home following a 4-1 road trip to meet the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers (A, Timber Rattlers) for the second game of a three-game series. The LumberKings lost the head-to-head meetings with Wisconsin in 2018 eight games to 11 with a poor 4-8 mark at home. This will be the first meeting between the two teams in 2019. In total they will meet 18 times this year. The LumberKings earned the walk-off win 5-4 to capture their fifth win over their last six games.

**LumberKing Starter:** Peyton Culbertson, 22, makes his third appearance and start of the year with the LumberKings. The Arkansas State product worked 3.2 innings against the Beloit Snappers at Harry Pohlman Field. Culbertson allowed five runs, three earned, on four hits while walking a career high five batters and striking out two. In his season debut, he worked 5.2 innings against the Kane County Cougars in Clinton allowing just one run on four hits while walking one and striking out six. He was taken by the Miami Marlins in the 8th round of the 2018 MLB Draft. Culbertson made his professional debut for the GCL Marlins on June 25th and made just one more appearance before being promoted to the Batavia Muckdogs. Culbertson finished his first season of his professional career with a 1-3 record and 2.34 ERA over 34.2 innings of work. Came out of high school ranked as Tennessee's 15th best baseball prospect after guiding his team to a CHS State Championship in 2013.

**Timber Rattlers Starter:** Adam Hill, 22, makes his third appearance and second start of the season for the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers. The South Carolina native was given a no decision his last time out against the Quad Cities River Bandits. Hill came out after just 2.1 innings of work allowing two runs on two hits while walking one and striking out none. In his season debut – a start in Peoria against the Chiefs – he allowed no runs over five innings walking two and striking out six and earned the win. The Milwaukee Brewers selected him in the 4th round of the 2018 MLB Draft out of the University of South Carolina. Was drafted out of high school in 2015 by the San Diego Padres in the 39th round but did not sign.

**Not Coming Easy:** Thursday night's series opening win over Wisconsin fit an unfortunate theme to the start of the year for the LumberKings – wins that do not come easy. Clinton lead 4-0 before scoring in the 10th for a walk-off win marking the fifth time this season that the LumberKings had held a lead lost it and gone on to win.

**Home Run Party:** Clinton's early lead on Thursday night was built on the long ball. Ricardo Cespedes hit his first home run of the year in the fifth and Demetrius Sims broke out for his first multi-home run game of his professional career. Sims had come into the game with just one career on his professional career but homered in the first and then seventh inning to triple his career total.

**Good Signs:** A big part of Clinton's offense in 2019 will be the bats of Sean Reynolds and Will Banfield. Both LumberKings were featured prominently in Thursday night's win. Reynolds had his first multi-hit game of the season with a pair of doubles and an RBI while Banfield too collected his first multi-hit game of the year that included a double, a run scored, and the game winning hit in the 10th.

**Road Warriors:** The road trip the LumberKings are coming off of was a successful one. Scheduled to be a six-game trip, Clinton lost one game in Beloit due to cold weather and snow but ended the trip going 4-1 to make up for their first homestand ending with a 1-4 mark. The success on the road has meant back-to-back series wins and a .500 record of 6-6 coming into the series with the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers.

**This Date in Baseball History:** On this date in 2013, after stealing second base, Jean Segura attempts to swipe third, but when the play ends the Brewers shortstop is standing on first as he aborts his journey to third and mistakenly thinking he is automatically out when he finds teammate Ryan Braun occupying second base, he heads for the dugout before taking refuge at first upon realizing he is still safe. Two pitches later, the bewildered Milwaukee baserunner is thrown out trying to steal second base again to become the first player to have stolen second and then is caught stealing the same base in the same inning.
