In Case You Missed It: The Baysox were swept in a doubleheader yesterday by the Harrisburg Senators. In the first game, Bowie jumped out to a 5-0 lead in the second inning, thanks in-part to a three-run home run from **Ryan McKenna**. However after the five run outburst in the second, the Senators scored six unanswered runs, and won the seven inning game 6-5 on a walk-off sacrifice fly. The Baysox got off to a good start again in game two, as **Rylan Bannon** hit a first inning home run to make it 1-0. In the second, **Chris Clare** picked up his first AA hit and RBI, giving Bowie a 2-0 advantage. Once again, the offense struggled late in the game, and Harrisburg came back to secure a 4-2 win and a doubleheader sweep.

Lowther's Debut: LHP **Zac Lowther** makes his Eastern League debut on the mound today for the Baysox. Since being drafted by Baltimore in the second round of the 2017 MLB Draft, Lowther has dominated during his stops in Aberdeen, Delmarva and Frederick. In 2018, Lowther started the year in Delmarva, and posted a 1.16 ERA in six starts. He was then called-up to Frederick at the end of May, and excelled there as well going 5-3 with a 2.53 ERA in 92.2 innings. In total on the season, Lowther had a 151/35 K/BB ratio in 123.2 innings. At the end of the season, Lowther was named the Co-Jim Palmer Award Winner, given to the best minor league pitcher in the organization. Lowther shared the honor with former Baysox LHP Keegan Akin, who was the Eastern League Pitcher of the Year. Lowther enters 2019 as the eighth-ranked prospect in the Orioles system.

In the Other Corner: RHP **Sterling Sharp** starts for the Senators today, looking to help secure a four-game sweep to start the season. Sharp, the ninth-ranked prospect in the Nationals organization, is back in Harrisburg after making his final 13 starts of 2018 with the Senators. In 68.2 innings, Sharp went 6-3 with a 4.33 ERA. Prior to his promotion in June, Sharp made 14 starts with A-Potomac, going 5-3 with an ERA of 3.16, earning him Carolina League Mid-Season All-Star honors. Sharp was selected by the Nationals in the 22nd round of the 2016 MLB Draft out of Drury University.

You Look Familiar: Many of the players on the Baysox roster saw their fair share of Harrisburg starter **Sterling Sharp** in 2018. While pitching for the Potomac Nationals, Sharp made two early-season starts against the Frederick Keys, the Orioles high-A affiliate. On May 13, Sharp started against current Baysox LHP **Brian Gonzalez**. Baysox OF **Ryan McKenna** had four hits in that contest, and the Keys won 8-6. On June 7, Baysox INF **Chris Clare** had an RBI off of Sharp in a 4-2 Keys win. After his promotion to Harrisburg, Sharp pitched against the Baysox on July 4. OF **Ademar Rifaela** and IF **Anderson Feliz** each had RBIs against Sharp, and Bowie won the game 7-6 in 10 innings.

Top Tier Talent: The Bowie Baysox roster is filled with some of the top prospects in the Orioles' farm system. According to MLB.com, seven of the top 30 prospects in the organization will begin the season in Bowie. Outfielder **Yusniel Diaz** headlines the roster, coming into the year as Baltimore's number one prospect. Outfielder **Ryan McKenna** (#7) and Left-Handed Pitcher **Zac Lowther** (#8) also rank in the Orioles' top ten. Pitchers **Hunter Harvey** (#12), **Dillon Tate** (#18), **Zach Pop** (#20) and Infielder **Rylan Bannon** (#23) round out the top prospects that start the 2019 campaign with the Baysox.

The Buck Starts Here: 2019 marks Buck Britton's first season as manager of the Bowie Baysox. Britton replaces Gary Kendall, who was the head man in Bowie from 2011-2018. Last season, Britton managed the Delmarva Shorebirds, leading the club to a 68-66 record. Prior to getting into coaching, Britton played nine seasons in Minor League Baseball, and spent parts of 2009, 2011, 2012, 2013 and 2014 with the Baysox. Buck is the brother of former Baysox and Orioles' left-hander Zack Britton.

This Day in Baysox History: April 7 has been a tough day for the Baysox over the past few seasons. In fact, Bowie has not won a game on April 7 since 2006, when it beat Reading 4-0. **Adam Loewen** started that game for the Baysox, going eight scoreless innings, allowing just one hit and striking out 12. **Brooks Badeaux** and **Leo Daigle** each had two hits in the win.

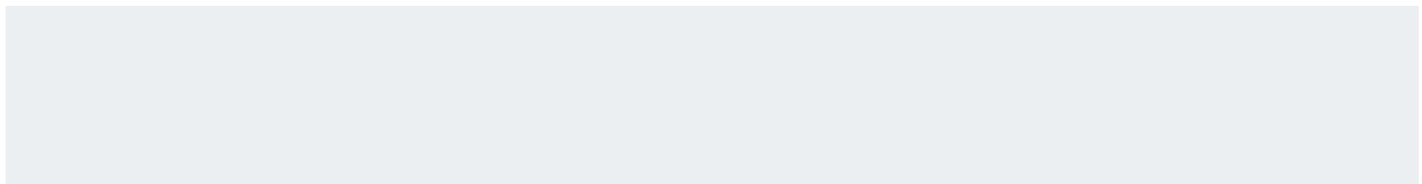
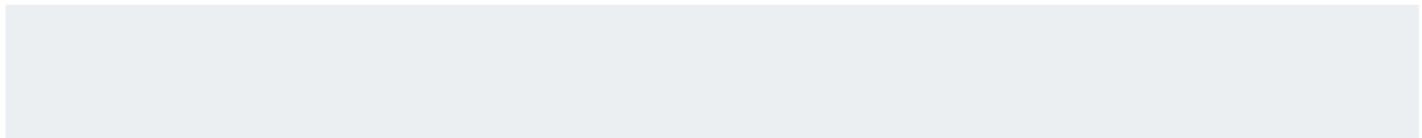
