Today's Preview: The Clinton LumberKings (A, Mariners) meet the Quad Cities River Bandits (A, Astros) for the second time this season with the second game of a three-game series. The teams met for the first time this season at Ashford University Field May 29-31 with the LumberKings taking two out of three. After dropping the first game to the River Bandits 4-2 Clinton went on to take game two 13-6 and game three 5-2. The LumberKings trail the all-time series, dating back to 1960, 414 to 453. Since Clinton has been affiliated with the Seattle Mariners (2009) they are trailing in the head-to-head matchups 72 games to 73.

LumberKings Starter: Clay Chandler, 24, makes his 13th appearance and sixth start of the season for the Clinton LumberKings. The Kentucky native, made his fourth straight start his last time out, earning the win against the Kane County Cougars. Chandler worked a professional career high seven innings during his time out in addition to striking out a professional career high eight batters. He allowed two runs on five hits while walking none. Chandler has been in the LumberKings starting rotation since the trade of Tommy Romero to the Tampa Bay Rays organization. He began the season as Clinton's long reliever but during his second outing of the year made his first spot start of the season, game one of a doubleheader with the Kane County Cougars on April 8th. Since being inserted in the LumberKings rotation, Chandler has lasted at least five innings in each of his starts. The Seattle Mariners signed him as an undrafted free agent out of Southeast Missouri State University on June 29, 2017.

River Bandits Starter: Leovanny Rodriguez, 22, makes his sixth appearance and fourth start of the season for the Quad Cities River Bandits. This will mark a return to the starting rotation for the Dominican native. He last appeared in relief for Quad Cities working three-inning against the Peoria Chiefs on June 8. Rodriguez allowed two runs on three hits while walking two and striking out six. The righty last pitched as a starter on June 2 against the Beloit Snappers and was hit hard. Over five innings he allowed seven runs on 10 hits while walking three and striking out two. Rodriguez spent two seasons in the Dominican Summer League 2015 and 2016 before making his state side debut with the Gulf Coast League Astros in '16. The Houston Astros signed him as an international free agent on June 10, 2015.

Last Time Out: Nick Wells struck out a professional career high nine batters on Tuesday night at Modern Woodmen Park but the Clinton LumberKings feel in shutout fashion to the Quad Cities River Bandits, 4-0. The loss marked the first time this season that Clinton (37-28) was shutout in a nine-inning game. The LumberKings had few chances against the River Bandits (35-30) pitching throughout the night. In the top of the first, Joseph Rosa walked to open the game and was quickly picked off before Ariel Sandoval doubled to left and was followed by a Ryan Costello walk. Sandoval was then thrown out in an attempted double steal at third and no runs scored when Johnny Adams was struck out looking to end the inning. Enoli Paredes worked five innings of relief for Quad Cities after Dean Deatz was removed after one inning in a planned rehab assignment. The River Bandits added the final run of the night in the bottom of the eighth off LumberKings reliever Marvin Gorgas.

A Chance to Clinch: The LumberKings enter Quad Cities with a chance to clinch a playoff spot for the first half in the Western Division. Clinton currently owns a magic number of four to clinch at least a wild card meaning, if the LumberKings were to take two of three from the River Bandits, Clinton will be celebrating a playoff berth at Modern Woodmen Park. The LumberKings own a one game lead in the Western Division over the Peoria Chiefs. The magic number to clinch the West is six coming into Tuesday night's game.

First of Its Kind: The Clinton LumberKings have been shutout three times this season, tied for third fewest in the Midwest League, yet Tuesday's 4-0 loss to Quad Cities was the first of its kinds, a nine-inning shutout. In Clinton's previous two shutout losses, they came in seven games during doubleheader contests. The shutout loss was the first for the LumberKings since falling to the Burlington Bees 4-0 in game one of a doubleheader on May 22 at Ashford University Field.

New Heights: The pitching was strong for Clinton in Tuesday night's loss led by starter Nick Wells. The lefty struck out nine to set a new professional career high for strikeouts in a game. The punchouts also were the most by a LumberKings pitcher since Danny Garcia struck out 11 Beloit Snappers at Ashford University Field on May 12, 2017.

Going to the Derby: Ryan Costello will be one of the four LumberKings in Lansing this year for the All-Star game. The day will be busy for Costello who accepted an invitation to participate in this year's home run derby. He leads the team in home runs, nine, coming into this series and also owns the longest home run hit at Ashford University Field this year, a 461 foot smash against the Dayton Dragons on Sunday, May 6th.

LumberKings All-Stars: The All-Star announcements are here and the Clinton LumberKings will be a well-represented team in Lansing on June 19th. Jack Larsen will start for the Western Division All-Stars while teammate Ryan Costello will come off the bench. Pitchers Ryne Inman and Collin Kober will represent Clinton and come out of the bullpen. All four of the LumberKings representatives will be making their first all-star game appearances of their professional career.

This date in baseball history: On this date in 2006, the first wireless bullpen communication system in baseball history is used at Wrigley Field when a cell phone, which will be sent to the Hall of Fame, is used for the first time in major league history to call the bullpen. From the dugout, Cubs pitching coach Larry Rothschild calls the bullpen during the third inning to start warming up reliever Angel Guzman.
