Today's Preview: The Clinton LumberKings (A, Mariners) meet the Peoria Chiefs (A, Cardinals) for the finale of a four-game set and will meet each other 15 times this season. Over the two teams 15 meetings in 2017, the LumberKings dropped eight games to the Chiefs to lose the season series 7-8. Clinton could not defend home field and dropped all but two of the seven meetings at Ashford University Field. At Dozer Park the LumberKings fared better and won five out of the eight meetings. The LumberKings trail the all-time series, dating back to 1983, 238 to 214. Since Clinton has been affiliated with the Seattle Mariners (2009) they lead the head-to-head matchups 77 games to 55.

LumberKings Starter: Nick Wells, 22, makes his eighth start of the season for the LumberKings. The Virginia native took the loss his last time out. The lefty worked a five-inning outing on the road against the South Bend Cubs in which he allowed three runs on four hits while walking four and striking out three. Wells is in his third season with the LumberKings and was awarded the Opening Day start for the LumberKings, his first with Clinton. After taking the win in his first two decisions of the season, Wells has taken the loss in his last decisions. He was originally drafted by the Toronto Blue Jays, out of high school, in the third round of the 2014 Draft. At the trade deadline, on July 31, 2015, he was traded to the Seattle Mariners. The Blue Jays sent Wells along with fellow left-handers Jacob Brentz and Rob Rasmussen to the Mariners in exchange for right-handed reliever Mark Lowe.

Chiefs Starter: Zach Prendergast, 23, makes his seventh appearance and fourth start of the season for the Peoria Chiefs. The Pennsylvania native earned the win his last time out. Prendergast worked seven innings against the Dayton Dragons in Dayton, his longest start of the season, allowing two runs, one earned, on three hits while walking none and striking out five. Prendergast was signed as a nondrafted free agent out of Seaton Hall University following his senior season in 2017. He was recruited out of Hatboro-Horsham High School where he threw a no-hitter in 2012. In high school the righty both pitched and played and the infield before focusing full time on his pitching when getting to Seaton Hall.

Last Time Out: The biggest inning allowed by Clinton LumberKings pitching this season was the difference in a 7-5 loss to the Peoria Chiefs on Wednesday afternoon at Dozer Park. Peoria (20-16) rallied for six runs in the bottom of the eighth to hand the LumberKings (19-16) their third straight loss. Clinton jumped on Chiefs starter Alvaro Seijas early, scoring the game's first run in the top of the first. Joseph Rosa led the game off with a double and scored four batters later when Johnny Adams singled through the right-side of the infield. The hit extended Adams hitting streak to 11-games, the longest by a LumberKing this season. The four-run lead held until reliever Kyle Wilcox entered to work the bottom of the eighth. The Chiefs sent ten men to the plate in the inning, registering five hits and scoring six runs to take a 7-5 lead. The implosion of the LumberKings in the eighth was the most runs surrendered in any inning this season.

Rally Killers: Despite five runs and an early 5-0 lead for the LumberKings, the Clinton offense stalled in what could have been a far stronger offensive performance on Wednesday afternoon in Peoria. Four times in Wednesday's game LumberKings bounced into rally killing doubleplays. The twin killings were the most turned against the LumberKings this season.

The Road Bites Back: A rough start to the four-game series with the Peoria Chiefs has moved the LumberKings out of first place in the Western Division following three straight losses in Peoria. Clinton had begun the 10-game road trip, longest of the season, by taking the first two series against the West Michigan Whitecaps and South Bend Cubs. The losses in the first three games of the series to the Chiefs means Clinton will take the series loss, their first of the season to come on the road.

Ouch: Wednesday's loss to the Chiefs hurt in more ways than one. The loss was the third straight, first time this season Clinton has lost three straight games to Western Division rivals and came in come from behind fashion with the LumberKings blowing their largest lead of the year, five runs. The loss also marked the first time in 2018 that Clinton lost a game when leading after seven innings.

The Flood Gates Open: The eighth inning of Wednesday's loss is an inning that has should the short comings of LumberKings pitching this season. The big inning showed its ugliest struggles this season showed its ugliest side in the loss on Wednesday afternoon. Kyle Wilcox, who had not allowed a run in his previous two outings, allowed 10 Chief to come to the plate and score six runs. The inning was the biggest allowed by Clinton pitching this year.

Bullpen Fades: The heavy load placed on the bullpen in the month of May caught up to the LumberKings on Wednesday afternoon. A lack of five inning starts, or longer, by Clinton starters has left a bullpen heavily taxed coming into the series finale on Thursday night. Clinton has seen the bullpen ERA balloon to 4.07 after beginning the series with a collective ERA of 3.33. The six-run eighth inning on Wednesday combined with the nine earned runs allowed by Adonis De La Cruz on Tuesday explains the rotten stretch by LumberKings relievers.

Adams Streaking: The first run scored on Wednesday afternoon came home on a Johnny Adams single through the right side of the infield in the top of the first inning. The hit marked the 11 straight game that Adams has hit safely in. The LumberKings shortstop is batting .419 or 18-for-43 during the streak, the longest active streak on the team. The hit streak is now the longest of the season by a LumberKing, passing Greifer Andrade's nine game streak that started the season running from April 7th to April 22nd.

This date in baseball history: On this date in 2015, the Marlins fire manager Mike Redmond (155-207), who had his contract extended through 2017 prior to the final game of last season as a reward for Miami improving by 15 victories during his second year at the helm. The 44 year-old skipper, after seeing his team get off to a disappointing 16-22 start, will be replaced by the team's general manager Dan Jennings, who has never played in the majors and has never managed at any professional level.

AGAINST THE CHIEFS: This will be Wells fourth career start against the Peoria Chiefs. The lefty is 1-1 against the Chiefs with all of his previous coming against Peoria in 2017. He has logged 13.2 innings while surrendering 17 runs walking five and striking out eight.

2017: Made 25 starts with A Clinton. Along with Ljay Newsome was the only starting pitcher to begin the season in the rotation and end the season in the rotation. Set a professional career high for strikeouts during his first outing of the season. The lefty struck out nine Beloit Snappers at Ashford University Field on April 10th but received a no decision for his work.
