Today's Preview: The LumberKings (A, Marlins) wrap up their four-game series with the Cougars (A, Diamondbacks) this afternoon. Clinton split the first games of the series in Kane County and took Saturday night's home opener 6-1 to move into a tie for first place in the Western Division. Thus far LumberKings pitching has allowed just four-run, three earned to start the season.

LumberKing Starter: Peyton Culbertson, 21, makes his LumberKings debut as the first pitcher to start under the Clinton Elotes Sunday rename. The Arkansas State University product was taken by the Miami Marlins in the 8th round of the 2018 MLB Draft. He made his professional debut for the GCI Marlins on June 25th and made just one more appearance before being promoted to the Batavia Muckdogs. Culbertson finished his first season of his professional career with a 1-3 record and 2.34 ERA over 34.2 innings of work. Came out of high school ranked as Tennessee's 15th best baseball prospect after guiding his team to a CHS State Championship in 2013.

Cougars Starter: Franklyn Soriano, 23, makes his 2019 debut after spending part of the 2018 season with Kane County. This will be his second outing against the LumberKings in his career. Last season he held Clinton scoreless over a six-inning outing in which he received a no decision. The Dominican native was signed as an international free agent on March 23rd, 2015. As a member of the Cougars starting rotation last year he powered them to a postseason push with a 2-3 record and 1.82 ERA in seven starts. Overall, Soriano has played in four professional seasons and gone 12-14 with a 4.04 ERA over 247 innings pitched.

Jerar's Start: While it is early in the year, LumberKings right fielder Jerar Encarnacion has stood out in just two games at the plate. In the season curtain lifter on Thursday in Kane County he went 3-for-4, all singles, and came back on Friday to go 3-for-5 with a double, a run scored, and a RBI.

New Affiliation: The Clinton LumberKings are in the first year of a new affiliation with the Miami Marlins. The Seattle Mariners, the previous affiliation, were in Clinton for 10 seasons (2009-18) – the second longest affiliation in franchise history behind the San Francisco Giants 15 seasons (1980-94). The Marlins are the 14th Major League team to affiliate in Clinton.

There They Go: Of the 12-position players on the LumberKings Opening Day roster they combined to steal 73 bases in 2018. It was not until Saturday night however that Clinton registered their first steals of the year. Christopher Torres has the honor of swiping the first bag of the year with his steal of third in the bottom of the sixth and Demetrius Sims added the second with a steal of second in the bottom of the seventh.

Walk This Way: LumberKings batters used patience to top the Cougars on Saturday night. Jerar Encarnacion led the way with three walks to establish a new career high and, in total, Clinton drew eight. Through the first three games the LumberKings have worked 17 walks, most in the league, and nine more than their opponent.

Prospecting: The Clinton LumberKings Opening Day roster included four top 30 prospects according to MLB.com. Outfielder Connor Scott (No.6), catcher Will Banfield (No. 10), infielder Chris Torres (No. 28), and outfielder Thomas Jones (No. 30).
