WEDNESDAY: The offenses started slow with just 3 hits combined between the teams through the first four innings, but it was the Fire Frogs who outlasted the Miracle in a 6-4 triumph. Drew Lugbauer had his first three-hit game of the season, going 3-4 with two doubles and 3 RBIs (fifth multi-RBI game of the season). His two-run double in the eighth off RHP Alex Phillips proved to be the difference. He also had an RBI single in the sixth right after Greyson Jenista's two-run double which put Florida in front for the first time. Riley Delgado went 2-5 and had an RBI as well. Kevin Josephina and Jeffrey Ramos continued their on-base streaks. RHP Matt Withrow got the start and permitted just one hit in 2 and 2/3's scoreless innings. RHP Brandon White walked four but earned his third win of the season, inducing two double plays and stranded the bases loaded in the 9th.

JOSEPHINA JUMPING: The Fire Frogs infielder hit .337 (26-77) with five doubles, eight RBIs, and 10 runs scored during the month of May. He raised his batting average from .196 at the end of April to the current .291. He's kept the bat going in the month of June by going 7-16 and reaching safely in all five games played and is on a season-best 11-game on-base streak.

RAMOS RAKING: Ramos got back on track with a hit yesterday, extending his on-base streak to 12 games and he is slashing .388 over this span. Going further back, the Dominican Republic native has recorded a knock in 14 of his last 16 ballgames, raising his average from .237 to .267.

DELGADO DIGS IN: The efficiency in which Riley Delgado has reached base this year is startling. He has gotten on in 49 of the 56 games he has logged a plate appearance and he has hits in 42 of those contests. He has separate 9-game (4/12-4/22) and 10-game (4/27-5/7) on-base streaks to his credit and is currently on a season-best 13 game streak. Delgado's .299 average is 7th in the FSL and he has two more hits (66) than anyone else in the league. Trevor Larnach is second with 64.

ROAD WEARY: The Fire Frogs began a seven-game road trip on Monday with a four-game series in Fort Myers followed by a weekend three-game set in Tampa. Florida has struggled on the road this year with a 11-18 mark. However, with yesterday's win, the Fire Frogs won back-to-back road games for the third time this season (4/4-4/5 at Daytona, 5/9-5/10 at Jupiter). Florida can improve upon their 1-6 road series record if they can win tonight in Fort Myers.

TODAY'S STARTER: The finale of the set will see 22-year-old RHP Nolan Kingham make his 9th start at the Advanced-A level... He was called up from Low-A Rome on 4/19, where he went 1-1 with a 0.56 ERA in three starts and 16 innings pitched: 12 H, 2 R, ER, HB, BB, 7 K... 2-0 with a 4.56 ERA in 2018 with Danville (Rk): 11 G, 3 GS, 1-2 SV, 23.2 IP, 27 H, 12 ER, 2 HR, HB, 7 BB, 18 K, .297 BAA... 12th Round selection in 2018 by the Braves out of Texas... His brother Nick pitches for the Pirates (4th Round pick in 2010)... Signed with the Braves for \$150,000... Also drafted by Milwaukee in the 39th Round in 2015... Youth and Community Studies major at Texas... Reliever only back in his freshman year at Texas but was elevated to a starter during his sophomore season... 8-5 record with a 4.57 ERA and 3 saves during his Junior (final) year with the Longhorns: 81 K, 24 BB, 62 R, 51 ER in 100.1 IP... Three year starter and he pitched and played shortstop and first base at Desert Oasis HS in Las Vegas. He had his scoreless innings streak snapped at 19 in the 4th of his 5/15 start vs. St. Lucie. He then went on to allow 22 R (19 ER) over his previous 3 outings until he blanked Palm Beach on 5/31, bookending May with CG shutouts.
