Today's Preview: The LumberKings (A, Marlins) meet the Cougars (A, Diamondbacks) for the second game of a four-game series before shifting to Clinton. Thursday night's 0-2 Opening Day loss was the first suffered by Clinton since falling 11-0 to the Cougars in the 2013 curtain lifter.

LumberKing Starter: Josh Roberson, 22, makes his LumberKings debut in Friday's matinee with the Cougars. The UNC Wilmington product was selected by the Miami Marlins in the 12th round of the 2017 MLB Draft. After sitting all of the 2017 season with an injury he made his professional debut with the GCL Marlins on June 23rd, 2018. By the end of the year he would be pitching with the Batavia Muckdogs and compiled a 6-4 record with a 1.30 ERA

Cougars Starter: Ryan Weiss, 22, comes into his Cougars debut as the Diamondbacks 18th best prospect - according to MLB.com. The Wright State University product was taken in the fourth round of the 2018 MLB Draft and made his professional debut on June 24th with the AZL Diamondbacks. He earned a promotion to Hillsboro on June 25th and ended his year going 0-1 with a 3.86 ERA. Weiss missed his entire first season at Wright State after herniating a disc and fracturing a vertebrae in his back while overdoing weightlifting.

A Change To The Rule: Prior to the start of the Midwest League season another round of rules changes were handed down with the aim of affecting pace of play. This season will see the Single-A level limit their coach and player mound visits from 10 in 2018 to 9 in 2019. Any players, coaches, or managers in violation of this rule are subject to ejection.

Hey, No Pressure: Seven-year Major League veteran Mike Jacobs comes to Clinton to head the LumberKings. The 55th Manager in franchise history has been written about during the offseason for his role that he will play in the Marlins rebuild. Wells Dusenbury of the Sun Sentinel said that Jacobs position will be "vital role in a Miami rebuilding process."

He Knows These Guys: While all of the LumberKings Opening Day players are new faces given the affiliation change several faces will be familiar to Manager Mike Jacobs. Last season in Batavia - his second year with the Muckdogs - he had 14 of the players on the current roster. Seven pitcher - C.J. Carter, Peyton Culbertson, Alberto Guerrero, Josh Roberson, Manuel Rodriguez, Chris Vallimont, and Zach Wolf. And seven position players - J.D. Osborne, Bubba Hollins, Sean Reynolds, Demetrius Sims, Chris Torres, Ricardo Cespedes, Michael Donadio, and Jerar Encarnacion.

New Affiliation: The Clinton LumberKings are in the first year of a new affiliation with the Miami Marlins. The Seattle Mariners, the previous affiliation, were in Clinton for 10 seasons (2009-18) - the second longest affiliation in franchise history behind the San Francisco Giants 15 seasons (1980-94). The Marlins are the 14th Major League team to affiliate in Clinton.

League Leader: Sean Reynolds is a hard LumberKing to miss given his 6'7" frame but it was his power that stood out to many in 2018 with Batavia. The 2016 4th round pick led the New York-Penn League in home runs (17), RBIs (52), Runs (49), and strikeouts (133).

Prospecting: The Clinton LumberKings Opening Day roster included four top 30 prospects according to MLB.com. Outfielder Connor Scott (No.6), catcher Will Banfield (No. 10), infielder Chris Torres (No. 28), and outfielder Thomas Jones (No. 30).

This Date in Baseball History: On this date in 1989, at Riverfront Stadium, Dodgers' hurler Orel Hershiser's scoreless-inning streak ends at 59. With two outs in the bottom of the first, Todd Benzinger's single scores Barry Larkin, who had been picked off after getting a base hit to lead off the game, but was safe on the 'Bulldog's' throwing error.
