TRIBE TIPS

LAST NIGHT: The Indians overcame a 3-0 deficit with a three-run sixth, but the Mud Hens used five home runs on the night -- including three over the final two innings -- to put away Indy, 11-3. Will Craig plated the Tribe's first run with an RBI single in the sixth and two batters later, Jason Martin tripled off the glove of CF Daz Cameron to score two more. Back-to-back homers by Jeimer Candelario and Christin Stewart put Toledo back in front 6-3 in the eighth, and they added five runs in the ninth for the win. Alex McRae gave up a pair of home runs early on as Indy fell behind, only to claw back as McRae kept the visitors in check. He finished with seven innings of three-run ball, fanning five while scattering four hits and three walks.

AND IT'S GONE: Through the first 22.5 seasons at Victory Field, Indy's pitching staff only had three games at home where they surrendered four home runs, first doing so on June 3, 2008 vs. Lehigh Valley. They also gave up four dingers on July 26, 2017 vs. Rochester and July 15, 2018 vs. Toledo. This season alone, the Indians have had individual games at The Vic where they've allowed four (July 17 vs. Syracuse), five (last night vs. Toledo) and seven home runs (July 15 vs. Syracuse). Indy has surrendered a franchise-record 152 home runs this season (old record: 145 in 2005) and the Tribe are on pace to give up 159 jacks.

MUSICAL CHAIRS: RHP Yefry Ramirez was recalled by Pittsburgh ahead of last night's game; Ramirez was originally slated to start today's game vs. Toledo. Instead, the Tribe will turn to RHP James Marvel (5-0, 2.72) for his 10th Triple-A start. In his last 15 starts between Double-A Altoona and Indy, the Curve and Indians have combined for a 14-1 record. Six of Marvel's nine starts have been quality starts, tied for third most on the team, despite him only being with the Indians since July 5.

THE STARS ALIGN: RHP Mitch Keller was named the International League Most Valuable Pitcher yesterday, joining former Indians Fritz Ackley (1963), Ben Hendrickson (2004) and Steven Brault (2017) who also won the award. Keller is currently on the IL leaderboard with 123 strikeouts and led the league with a 3.56 ERA at the time of his latest promotion to Pittsburgh. UTIL Jake Elmore joined him as the IL postseason All-Star team's second baseman. He is currently second in the IL with a .337 batting average (116-for-344). Elmore is also third in OBP (.406) and fifth in doubles (31). Indy went 21 seasons in the IL without a second baseman named to the postseason All-Star team, but now have had a representative at that position each of the last two seasons (Kevin Kramer in 2018).

MOW 'EM DOWN, MONTANA: RHP Montana DuRapau is closing in on Indy's longest scoreless streak for the season. After a two-inning shutout appearance Monday night, he hasn't allowed a run in his last 15.1 innings of work (11 games), with the Tribe's season long being 16.0 consecutive scoreless innings by James Marvel. During that stretch, DuRapau has fanned 26 and allowed just eight of 54 total batters to reach base, good for a 0.52 WHIP and .098 opposing batting average. On Friday, he nailed down his 10th save in as many opportunities. DuRapau, 27, is now 64-for-70 (91.4 percent) in career save chances and hasn't been charged with a blown save since May 13, 2017 with Double-A Altoona.

THE CATCHERS: Indianapolis' catching corps ranks last in the IL with a collective .211 average and .627 OPS. Indy's primary second-half duo of Steven Baron (.182, 8-for-44) and Christian Kelley (.140, 13-for-93) have combined for three home runs, three doubles and 13 RBI since the All-Star break. Defensively, the two have combined to throw out 33.3% of basestealers (42-for-126) on the season, with Baron leading the way at 36.4% (20-for-55).

THE PONCE PARTY: RHP Cody Ponce made one Double-A start in 30 games between Altoona and Biloxi before transferring to Indy's rotation full-time. As a bullpen arm, he went 1-3 with a 3.48 ERA (16er/41.1ip) and 48 strikeouts (10.45 K/9). As a starter with the Tribe, he has a 4.15 ERA (6er/13.0ip) and 17 strikeouts (11.77 K/9). On Aug. 21 he fanned a season-high eight batters, beating his previous high of five which he also set in Triple-A.

GO TO J-MART: Since June 19, OF Jason Martin has hit safely in 40 of 53 games, with only two stretches of back-to-back games without reaching base. He has hit safely in eight of his last 11 games and 22 of his last 27 with a .326 average (31-for-95), two triples, 10 doubles, 19 RBI and 10 runs scored. He was hitting just .216 (36-for-167) with 15 RBI through June 18 and has since hit .314 (58-for-185) with 33 RBI.

THE HEAT IS ON: UTIL Jake Elmore is currently 0-for-5 in the first two games of the series vs. Toledo, lowering his average to .337 (116-for-344), three points behind Durham's Jake Cronenworth. Elmore has hit safely in 18 of his last 23 and 21 of his last 27 games overall. Indy's last batting champion was Junior Noboa (.340) in 1989 and they have had just four batting titles since 1969 (Bernie Carbo in 1969, Gene Locklear in 1972, Dallas Williams in 1987).

TIED FOR SECOND: Since Aug. 1, Indy has gone from 6.0 games back in the IL West to 12.0 games back, compiling a 9-17 record for the month. On the other hand, Toledo has stayed put, going from 13.5 GB to 12.0 with a 16-9 record. Indy leads the season series against the Mud Hens, 12-11, with two games to play, but Indy has lost five of its last six vs. Toledo. The Tribe haven't finished below .500 against the Mud Hens since 2014 (10-11). They are 34-32 vs. the IL West with six divisional games to play; Indy has finished over .500 in the division each of the last two years and six of the last seven overall.

WOOD BATS: OF Eric Wood has hit safely in 11 of his last 16 games with a single last night. In August, he is hitting .291 (16-for-55) with two doubles, a home run and four RBI. In 57 games prior to the PanAm Games, he hit just .226 (36-for-159). Wood leads the team with 85 at-bats as a designated hitter and holds a team-high .271 average (23-for-85) among Indy's DHs with more than 20 at-bats.

Today's Starter: Right-hander James Marvel will try to break the Tribe's three-game losing skid today. The 25-year-old began the season with Double-A Altoona and went 9-5 with a 3.16 ERA (35er/99.2ip).

Pitcher of the Week: Marvel earned his first career weekly honor on April 21 when he was named the Eastern League Pitcher of the Week after throwing the first shutout and fourth complete game of his career on April 20 at Richmond. He had just three base runners in the game on one hit, one walk and one error.

July Player of the Month: Marvel was named as Indy's July Player of the Month after going 3-0 with a 2.12 ERA (7er/29.2ip), 30 strikeouts, 0.81 WHIP and .146 average against in five starts.

Last Outing: Marvel earned his fifth Triple-A win against Louisville last week with a two-run, seven inning outing. He gave up six hits and fanned six to bounce back from a three-inning start against Lehigh Valley.

Ten Straight: Marvel has won ten consecutive decisions dating back to June 8 with Altoona. He has thrown 6.0-plus innings in 11 of those 14 starts and holds a 2.33 ERA (22er/85.0ip) with 68 strikeouts during the stretch.

Against the Mud Hens: Marvel made his first Triple-A start against Toledo and threw a complete-game shutout (seven innings). He struck out six and only allowed three hits.

Miscellaneous: Selected by PIT in the 36th round (1,087th overall) of the 2015 First-Year Player Draft out of Duke University. ... Also selected by MIN in the 37th round (1,120th overall) of the 2012 First-Year Player Draft but did not sign. ... Was one of 10 finalists for the ESPN High School Mr. Baseball Player of the Year Award in 2012. ... Missed the 2015 season while recovering from Tommy John surgery.
