Today's Preview: The Clinton LumberKings (A, Mariners) meet the Cedar Rapids Kernels (A, Twins) for the third time this season with the opener of a six game-set. This is the LumberKings second visit to Cedar Rapids in 2018, the LumberKings took the only meeting between the two teams when they visited April 19-21 due to cold temperatures and snow. The LumberKings trail the all-time series, dating back to 1963, 432 to 464. Since Clinton has been affiliated with the Seattle Mariners (2009) they trail in the head-to-head matchups 68 games to 86.

LumberKings Starter: Oliver Jaskie, 22, makes his ninth appearance and start of the season for the Clinton LumberKings. The Michigan native brings in a LumberKings season long losing streak to the series opener tonight. Jaskie has been hung with the loss his last four times out for Clinton. He pitched well enough to earn the win his last time out with 5.1 innings of work in which he surrendered three runs on a season high nine hits while walking none and striking out four against the Cedar Rapids Kernels. The start was the lefties first career start against the Cedar Rapids Kernels. The month of May has not been kind to Jaskie thus far as he has begun the month 0-4 with an 8.84 ERA compared to a month of April where he was very sharp posting a 1-0 record to go with a 2.00 ERA. The Mariners selected Jaskie in the sixth round of the 2017 MLB draft out of the University of Michigan where he was teammates with 2017 Clinton LumberKing Johnny Slater.

Kernels Starter: Bryan Sammons, 23, makes his eighth appearance and start of the season for the Cedar Rapids Kernels. The North Carolina native last worked against the Clinton LumberKings on May 19 back at Ashford University Field. Sammons was given the no decision for his time out, going 4.2 innings while allowing two runs on four hits while walking two and striking out four. The start was his second of the season against Clinton. On April 13th in Cedar Rapids, he made his second start of the season against the LumberKings and was given the loss for a 5.1 inning outing in which he was out dueled by Tommy Romero. Sammons allowed just one run to Clinton back in April he held the LumberKings four hits while walking a season high three batters and striking out three. He finished the 2017 season with the Kernels but did not face the LumberKings during the Kernels post season run. The 6'4" lefty was taken by the Minnesota Twins out of Western Carolina in the 8th round of the 2017 MLB Draft.

Last Time Out: A four-run 10th inning rally by the Clinton LumberKings on Thursday night at Ashford University Field was enough to drop the Burlington Bees in walk-off fashion for the third time in the series. In a game dominated by pitching the LumberKings (24-20) rode their largest inning, four runs, in over a week to take the series from the Bees (19-25). Ray Kerr started for Clinton and turned in his second straight quality start holding the Bees scoreless over his six innings of work while allowing four hits on one walk and striking out seven. Kerr's opposite number, Simon Mathews matched him over his five innings of work for Burlington. The Bees starter did not allow a hit while walking two and striking out five. Burlington then put up three runs in the top of the 10th off LumberKings reliever Marvin Gorgas. Leonardo Rivas drove home the first run with a double and Gurwitz lined an RBI triple to right center field for the second run. Franklin Torres capped the rally with an RBI single off Gorgas (2-0) to make it 4-1 Bees. Clinton then came roaring back against Bees' reliever Jorge Tavarez in the bottom of the 10th. Eugene Helder singled to open the inning to put runners at first and third with nobody out and moved to third on Sandoval's second run scoring double of the night. Ryan Costello then doubled into right center field to tie the game at four. Dimas Ojeda drove home Costello from second with a one out walk-off single to right against Tavarez (2-4).

It's Been Awhile: Thursday night's win made it seven straight games now that the LumberKings have been out hit by their opponent. The last time Clinton out hit the opposition was on the first night of the now just completed homestand, Friday night, against Cedar Rapids. Over the stretch, the LumberKings are being out hit 67 to 37.

Shaky Bullpen: Ray Kerr turned in another quality start for the LumberKings on Thursday night, the 10th by Clinton pitching this season. The lefty turned things over to the bullpen for the seventh inning to Scott Boches who continued the showing of strong pitching with two perfect innings of relief, setting down five of the six batters he faced by way of the strikeout. In the ninth, the LumberKings failed to maintain a 1-0 lead. Sam Delaplaine was given his first blown save of the season for allowing the game's tying run in the ninth. In the 10th, the Bees rallied for three runs off of Marvin Gorgas to take what looked like a commanding 4-1 lead before Clinton rallied for four runs to win the game in the bottom of the 10th.

Walk-off Will Do It: Another walk-off win for the Clinton LumberKings on Thursday night gave them the series three games to two. All of Clinton's wins in the series came in walk-off fashion. Louis Boyd was hit by a pitch with the bases loaded on Monday night to force home the winning run in game one, Eugene Helder induced a fielding error in the seventh inning of game two of a doubleheader on Tuesday that scored Ryan Scott for the game winner, and Dimas Ojeda singled home Ryan Costello in the 10th inning on Thursday night to complete a come from behind walk-off win.

Strikeout Central: The Clinton LumberKings closed out their series with the Burlington Bees on Thursday night with a 5-4 win in 10 innings. With the extra frame, LumberKings pitching added to their strikeout total to end the night with 16 strikeouts. On Wednesday night LumberKings pitching had combined for 15 strikeouts to give Clinton 31 strikeouts over their last two games.

This date in baseball history: On this date in 1922, after being called out for trying to stretch a single into a double, Babe Ruth throws dirt the umpire's eye, then goes after a heckler in the stands, and finishes his tirade by standing on the dugout roof calling the crowd "yellow" cowards. These actions will result in a one game suspension and a \$200 fine, and will cost the 'Bambino' his Yankee captaincy, a position he has held for less than a week.
